GUAPO was allowed to settled then rallied three wide on the turn, was in a long drive and powered to the front in late stretch to be best in the end. WHILE I dueled for the lead while two wide into the turn, was in a long drive but tired in late stretch. WAYLON'S GUITAR dueled for the lead while inside, was in a long drive but weakened in late stretch. CODE MANDALORE was unhurried early then made a mild rally while four wide in the stretch but was no threat. THE KWEEN'S KING was unhurried early and raced inside on the turn but was no threat. BATTLE PASS POSSE chased the early pace while three wide, was used up then gave way.
