SPEIGHTSVILLE pressed the pace while inside into the turn, was in a long drive and gamely dug in to be up for the place. ABSAROKA set a pressured pace from the start while two wide, was in a long drive but weakened and was out finished in late stretch. SEND OFF was unhurried early then rallied on the turn, was four wide in the stretch and made a late gain. TIGERS 'N BEARS was unhurried early on then rallied in upper stretch while two wide in the stretch but was no threat. SIXHOOFSEVENHOOF was unhurried early then failed to menace. QUARTERLY REPORT was saving ground on the inside into the turn then faltered in the stretch. THE LAST MOXY was unhurried early and was no threat.
