BROADWAY UNIONS stalked four deep to the far turn, latched onto the top trio around the bend, gained control at the top of the lane, cleared inside the eighth pole and held safely. MALIBU ROCKS broke in and bumped MIGHTY KAI, tracked outside that rival into the first turn, eased out to the four path around the bend, chased three then four wide on the second turn, tipped out for a clear run in the lane, finished well down the stretch and gained second. MIGHTY KAI got bumped leaving the gate, stalked from inside, tipped three wide at the quarter pole, finished willingly and earned the show honors. CUPID'S CRUSADER pressed the pace three deep early, moved up on even terms on the backstretch, took over in the three path past the five-sixteenths pole, fought two wide turning for home, relinquished the lead at the top of the stretch and flattened to fourth in the late stages. TEE N OFF vied inside a pair of rivals to the top of the lane, yielded in upper stretch and weakened. MISCHIEF MOMENTS vied between rivals to the five-sixteenths marker, yielded to the top trio at the quarter pole and also weakened.
