AS CATCH CAN stalked the top pair between rivals in the two path around the bend, tipped out entering the lane, took aim from outside with a furlong remaining but could not summon the needed late kick. TEQUILAANDTHERAPY settled outside a rival, took the turn two to three wide, moved out in the lane and got up for third at the wire. SCHILFLIED stalked the pace along the inside through the turn, moved out a bit entering the lane, chased behind the winner into the final furlong, failed to find the needed late punch and lost third at the wire. PRACTICAL DREAM went up to challenge CASALU from inside, inched ahead on the turn, lost command exiting the dirt, yielded to the winner in upper stretch and weakened. MAJOR TOM stalked the leaders from outside, bid four deep on the turn, took over late on the bend, kicked clear from NO D'ORO at the top of the lane and powered away under right handed urging and underhanded taps on the shoulder late. NO D'ORO stalked off the rail, bid three deep with three furlongs remaining, gained the lead past the five-sixteenths pole, lost command to MAJOR TOM late on the bend, could not kick on with the winner at the top of the lane and churned on to retain second. MR. FIGHTER disliked the kick back early and was asked to run up the backstretch, gained on the inside then two wide around the turn and ran on for the show honors. LOVE CANDY coaxed along off the pace wide up the backstretch, went three wide into the turn, moved into the two path then steered back out and came four wide into the lane and failed to threaten. BIG DON'S SMILING shook his head then hopped at the start, trailed up the backstretch, lacked room behind a pair of rivals early on the bend, tipped out and left bend in the three path and failed to menace. BERTACCHI dueled from outside, inched ahead past the three-eighths pole, lost command past the five-sixteenths marker and weakened. CARDINAL TRICK dueled from inside, yielded to outer rivals past the five-sixteenths pole and folded.

TERRY'S BOY cleared the field and moved inside, took pressure in the middle stages, carried a short lead through the far turn, put away outer rival in upper stretch and held gamely over a pair of rivals late. VANTASTIC tracked from inside, saved ground behind TERRY'S BOY through the far turn, moved out a bit in the lane, came with a late bid but was not enough. YACOWLEF (IRE) traveled two wide towards the rear, remained in the two path on the far turn, closed well through the lane, had to alter a bit from behind VANTASTIC past the sixteenth pole and kept gaining to the wire for a game third. OTTOMAN PRINCE (IRE) tracked in the two path, tipped three wide entering the lane and lacked a bid. SO I'M TOLD was closest in pursuit early from the two path,

applied pressure from outside in the middle stages, kept the heat on TERRY'S BOY through the far turn, then lost touch with the leader in upper stretch, almost had the rider lose his crop midstretch but made a nice save, then weakened in between foes late. HURRICANE CLOUD (GB) reserved in the two path, chased in range three deep at the quarter pole, spun four wide into the lane and flattened out. LIBERAL (IRE) saved ground off the pace and failed to menace. FOWLER BLUE raced a bit off the rail at the back around the first turn, traveled along the fence up the backstretch, moved out around the second bend, trailed three wide into the stretch and could not make an impact.
