LOLO LE PLUME stalked three then two wide on the first turn, applied pressure from outside on the backstretch, failed to keep up with the winner around the far turn, chased under left handed urging down the lane and finished a clear second. PREEM showed early speed inside MADAME SECRETARY into the clubhouse turn, took a stalking position behind that rival and became a bit rank midway around the bend, ridden along the fence through the far turn, weakened down the lane but managed to save third. WREN reserved at the back near the rail then in the two path, moved out a bit further on the backstretch, had one rival beat approaching the far turn, passed another rival while in the two path, kept trying in the lane but could not get by PREEM for third. BEEHAVIN bumped with MISS MAKENNA at the start, traveled outside a rival off the pace early, moved into range on the backstretch, dropped back three wide on the second bend, eased in the final furlong and walked off. MISS MAKENNA bumped leaving the gate, settled inside, trailed into the far turn, tired around the bend still on the fence, eased in the lane and walked off.

VELOCIOUS broke in a bit then went to the front, set the pace outside BOURBON GLAZE, shook free from that rival at the three-eighths pole and drew away around the bend, roused in upper stretch, asked right handed past the eighth pole and remained well clear under light coaxing in deep stretch. UNION COACH came in and bumped ARA leaving the gate, got through a crowded spot early, chased three deep into the turn, remained off the rail into the lane, could not make a dent in the winners' lead but kept on to best the rest. BOURBON GLAZE pressed the pace from inside to the turn, yielded to the winner with three furlongs remaining, chased on the rail to the lane and weakened. HONORABLE GAL brushed by outer rival at the start, chased outside ARA then between foes, went two then three wide around the turn, moved out further entering the lane and weakened. BAEZA stalked four wide into the first turn then angled to the two path, applied pressure from outside at the three-quarter pole, lost touch with FLYIN PRIVATE briefly on the backstretch then drew alongside once again at the half-mile marker, took over inside the three-eighths pole, put FLYIN PRIVATE away midway around the bend while under pressure from WESTWOOD, disposed of that rival late on the turn, kicked clear in upper stretch, drifted in when asked right handed midstretch and drew off under hand urging. MELLENCAMP tracked from inside into the first turn, had to alter out from behind VARNEY at the seven-eighths pole, moved back inside, stalked the top pair up the backstretch, went outside a rival on the far turn then cut the corner into the lane, finished willingly to earn the place honors but was no match for the winner. WESTWOOD chased five wide outside a rival into the first turn then angled to the three path, bid three deep with three furlongs remaining, could not keep up with BAEZA approaching the stretch and got outkicked by MELLEN CAMP for second. RANK settled in the two path early, had to alter out a bit at the seven-eighths pole then came back to the two path, chased three deep at the quarter pole, asked right hand entering the lane and faded. FLYIN PRIVATE coaxed to the front and led outside VARNEY into the first turn, cleared that rival and moved over to the rail, took pressure from BAEZA at the three-quarter pole, cleared that rival briefly before being confronted once again, relinquished the lead past the three-eighths pole, trailed into the stretch and tired. VARNEY raced up close on the inside into the first turn, shifted out and lost his action at the seven-eighths pole, was taken hold of and pulled up around the turn and walked off. THERE WAS A STEWARDS' INQUIRY INVOLVING VARNEY ON THE FIRST TURN AND RULED THAT HE CAUSED HIS OWN PROBLEMS AND NO CHANGE WOULD BE MADE.

CLOUSEAU bumped with outer rival at the start, settled in the two path off the pace, crept closer up the backstretch, saved ground through the far turn, angled out in upper stretch, rallied to the front with a sixteenth remaining and drove clear in the final strides. PASS THE BATON settled inside, moved into range in the middle stages, saved ground behind the top pair through the far turn, put in a rail bid and took over in upper stretch but got outkicked by CLOUSEAU in deep stretch. KERRY GOLD stalked from inside, moved outside the top pair on the backstretch, bid three deep into the second bend, dueled outside MINING DISTRICT past the five-sixteenths pole, took over late on the bend, lost command in upper stretch and stayed on to secure third. SPIRITUAL ADVISOR got bumped and lost his path leaving the gate, tracked in the three path on the first turn, went two wide into the second bend, asked while moved to the three path around the turn, drifted in near the sixteenth pole and flattened out. MINING DISTRICT sped clear and crossed over to the inside, took pressure on the backstretch, dueled into the far turn, fought with a pair of rivals early on the bend, dueled inside KERRY GOLD past the five-sixteenths pole and relinquished the lead, fought to the eighth pole, then weakened in the late stages. NAUVOO stalked in the two path, drew alongside the leader on the backstretch, vied between rivals on the far turn, yielded midway around the bend and weakened in the lane. BRONKO NAGURSKI stumbled a bit leaving the gate, trailed two wide then along the rail, chased two then three wide on the far turn, found the rail in the lane but failed to menace. MOTHER'S PRAYER traveled two wide around the first turn, came under a ride at the half-mile pole, dropped back on the far turn, eased in the stretch and walked off.

# Footnotes | View Glossary Of Terms

A FLEET RIDE coaxed along from off the pace well off the rail, angled down to the two path around the bend then came back out and chased four wide turning for home, closed in and reached the front midstretch, emerged clear at the sixteenth pole and held safely to the line. STUBBORN threw his head and broke inward in a poor beginning, trailed up the backstretch, raced widest through the turn, rallied from the middle portion of the track but was outclosed by the winner. MY SISTER LILLY chased under urging out of range, took the turn three then two wide, moved out in upper stretch and rallied for third. MISS MCKINZIE fought for the lead five, four, then three deep up the backstretch, continued to battle outside a pair of rivals on the turn, held a slim advantage at the quarter pole, dueled with DARLIN TAMI from upper to midstretch, then weakened in the final sixteenth. RIDEGOLD brushed leaving the gate, vied between rivals then chased the leaders past the nine-sixteenths pole, went two wide into the turn, tipped four wide at the quarter pole, raced three wide turning for home, followed within striking distance into the final furlong, then flattened late. DARLIN TAMI bumped leaving the gate, got floated out early fighting between runners, vied four then three deep up the backstretch, battled between foes in the two path around the bend, dueled inside a rival to

midstretch and weakened late. BIG JUSTICE rubbed the gate and broke slow, angled inside racing off the pace, saved ground under asking on the turn, tipped out in upper stretch and was never a factor. JOLIE CANDY bumped with outer rival at the start, drifted out early while showing speed, vied between rivals to the turn, fought along the rail around the bend, yielded at the top of the lane and folded in the final furlong. DAD'S BAD BUNNY brushed at the start, went up to vie inside several rivals for command, could not keep pace and chased past the half-mile pole, traveled along the rail then two wide into the lane, drifted out in the stretch and faded. KAPALUA RIDE showed early speed six deep then chased past the half-mile pole, dropped back in the four path on the turn and tired.
