OVER THE OCEAN cleared quickly and crossed over, raced keenly when taken in hand, vied inside a pair of rivals into the first turn, took control around the bend, dueled inside RESEMBLANCE then inched ahead past the half-mile pole, put that rival away at the five-sixteenths pole and held well under right handed urging. GOODFELLA (IRE) vied four deep into the first turn then took a stalking position in the three path outside a rival, chased two then three wide around the far turn, took aim at the leader in the final furlong, finished well to gain second but lacked the needed late punch to overtake the winner. JUNGLE PEACE (IRE) chased the lone speed outside rival early, moved over to the rail for the turn, challenged ENTRESSA at the eighth pole, cleared that rival in deep stretch and held over to the runner-up. FAVOR TO YOU reserved off the inside then advanced three deep between, shifted into the two path early on the turn, moved out to the three path for a bit before moving back in, chased within striking distance to the sixteenth pole, then dug in late to gain second but ran out of ground to overtake the winner. ENTRESSA broke a step slow, went up to take command from inside, set the pace from the fence to the stretch, challenged by the winner at the eighth pole, resisted to the sixteenth marker and got outkicked by the top pair late. KITTY MARREN coaxed along towards the rear while moving inward, entered the turn in the two path, ran into mild traffic at the five-sixteenths pole, tipped out and came three wide into the lane, then kept on to round out the superfecta. LILLIPUT traveled outside a rival at the back then trailed alone to the turn, traveled along the inside, ran into brief traffic nearing the quarter pole, angled out in the lane and lacked a rally. BRO BRO stalked up the backstretch, bid three deep into the turn, took over late on the bend, put away inner rivals in upper stretch and inched away from HORIZON WILDCAT in deep stretch. HORIZON WILDCAT brushed leaving the gate, reserved early on in the two path then drew closer up the backstretch, chased between rivals then spun three wide off the turn, took aim at BRO BRO with a furlong remaining but got turned away and held second. HOTHEAD stalked from inside into the turn, waited behind the top trio around the bend, roused in upper stretch while moving out a bit and gained the show honors. GEMINI BUZZ was closest in pursuit early on, bid two wide leaving the backstretch, fought between rivals through the turn, yielded to the winner while

drifting inward in upper stretch, continued to drift in near the rail in the final furlong and flattened to fourth.
