TARIFF set the pace on the fence under pressure from NEWLANDS, maintained a short lead through the far turn, cleared briefly entering the lane, met a pair of bids with a furlong remaining and gamely prevailed. SMILING TIZZY bobbed a bit leaving the gate but still came away with the field, stalked the top pair on the inside, saved ground to the stretch, tipped out drew alongside TARIFF at the eighth pole, fought between rivals into deep stretch, took a bump from UNRIVALD HERO, finished gamely but could not get by the winner. UNRIVALD HERO stalked in the two path, moved out three wide on the backstretch, took aim three deep entering the lane, bid three deep with a furlong remaining, drifted in and bumped SMILING TIZZY in deep stretch and kept on for a game third. MISSILE CRUISER reserved and taken to the inside, drew closer between rivals leaving the backstretch, angled in from behind NEWLANDS entering the lane, finished willingly chasing after the top trio but lacked the needed late punch. SPUN NOT STIRRED lacked early speed, trailed two wide into the first turn, started to pull and moved out to the three path around the bend, continued at the back in the two path on the second bend, angled out in the lane and failed to menace. NEWLANDS raced up close three wide into the first turn then pressed from outside in the two path, stayed alongside the leader to the quarter pole, lost touch with that rival exiting the bend and faded down the lane. THERE WAS A STEWARDS' INQUIRY INVOLVING THE STRETCH RUN BETWEEN SMILING TIZZY AND UNRIVALD HERO. FOLLOWING A REVIEW, THE STEWARDS RULED THAT UNRIVALD HERO DRIFTED IN AND INITIATED THE CONTACT WITH SMILING TIZZY AND THEREFORE NO CHANGE WAS MADE.

MONGOLIAN MAX stalked along the rail, tipped three wide past the five-sixteenths pole and challenged outside the top pair late on the bend, seized command in upper stretch, put away ALWAYS ON CAY at the eighth pole and was going away. ALWAYS ON CAY sped to the front and moved inside, took pressure from SALTWATER COWBOY then dueled inside that rival up the backstretch and far turn, carried a short lead inside a pair of rivals into the lane, yielded to the winner in upper stretch and kept on for a clear second. LONE SCOUT tracked two then three wide around the clubhouse turn, chased three deep leaving the backstretch, spun four wide into the lane and churned on to earn the show honors. FIREMAN DAN tracked in the two path to the far turn, chased two to three wide leaving the bend and weakened. SALTWATER COWBOY broke a step slow, raced up close to the outside the leader then applied pressure around the bend, raced keenly in hand entering the backstretch drawing on even terms with inner rival, fought two wide through the far turn, vied between rivals entering the lane, yielded shortly after and folded in the final furlong.

COASTAL COWGIRL hit the gate the gate, accelerated quickly to take control and clear the field, powered away on the inside through the turn, continued to widen when asked a couple times right-handed, then coasted through the final sixteenth. TOM'S STAR was closest in pursuit up the backstretch, lost ground in the two path through the turn and held second. AFFAIR stumbled leaving the gate, stalked in range three wide into the turn, came under a ride while watching the winner kick away around the bend and failed to respond down the lane. SPINNING chased outside TOM'S STAR then checked behind that rival at the nine-sixteenths pole and angled to the rail, saved ground through the turn and was never a factor. SASSY MISCHIEF away quickly then dropped back to last under coaxing, raced along the inside into the turn, eased over to the two path around the bend and was outrun.

PRIME AND READY stalked two wide into the turn, tipped out and challenged three deep with a quarter mile remaining, brushed while dueling with SPOTTED HAZE in upper stretch and drew clear late. SPOTTED HAZE dueled for the lead outside LIQUID SPIRIT, inched ahead around the bend, disposed of inner rival but now had to contend with PRIME AND READY entering the lane, took light contact from that rival in upper stretch, then got outkicked in deep stretch. CALI CAT took control early and crossed over, saved ground through the turn, roused at the top of the lane and stayed clear to the wire. FRANK BULLITT stalked CALI CAT along the rail, was closest in pursuit through the turn, moved out a bit to take aim at the top of the stretch, could not summon the needed late kick to reach the winner but was clearly second best. GOT'M COT'M traveled along the inside well off the pace, crept closer leaving the backstretch, went between foes midway around the bend, chased along the inside into the stretch and whittled the gap late. THE SHILLELAGH traveled outside a rival off the pace, lacked room behind a rival at the half-mile pole, ran into traffic near the five-sixteenths marker, chased two wide into the lane, moved out past the eighth pole and needed to find more. ROBIN'S TOUGH LOVE chased three deep or four wide into the turn, moved into the three path around the bend, challenged from outside with a furlong remaining, fought four deep into the last sixteenth and got outkicked by the winner. AUTISM INSPIRATION steadied when bothered by CARE FOR AUTISM early, tracked two wide into the turn, drew closer but lacked room behind the leaders a quarter mile out, bid inside the leader with a furlong left to run, led briefly midstretch but was overtaken by the winner when getting bumped by RYTHEM GIRL nearing the sixteenth pole and got outkicked for the place honors. GOT SOUL vied from inside then inched ahead around the first turn, cleared at the five-eighths pole, set all the pace to the stretch, carried a comfortable lead to midstretch and held safely late under urging. SABERTOOTH stalked two then three wide early, remained off the rail outside rivals into the far turn, tipped four wide at the quarter pole, finished willingly down the lane, drifted in and bothered SHAPOVAL late to gain second and closed the gap on the winner late. SHAPOVAL stalked from inside, got put tight on the first turn, stalked from inside to the stretch, moved off the fence in the lane, finished evenly

in the furlong grounds and lost second when getting floated in by SABERTOOTH late. SMOOTHWHISKYGOINDWN traveled in the two path well off the pace, lacked room behind a rival and steadied into the far turn along the inside, shifted to the two path into the clear, moved out in the stretch and improved position. BENNY'S PUZZLE off slow to begin, went three deep into the first turn, got bothered by inner rival and steadied a bit, angled down to the inside, steadied behind a rival at the five-eighths pole, saved ground around the far turn, moved off the fence and failed to make an impact. GIANT LUTHER settled inside, became rank and pulled badly causing the rider to take up on the first turn, moved out in the stretch and was never a factor. GLASS OF JAMESON raced up close three deep in hand, chased three then two wide around the far turn and weakened down the lane. MASTER JACQUES off slow in the beginning, reserved and tucked inside at the back, passed a pair of rivals from off the rail on the far turn but came up empty in the lane.
