PRIVATE GEM pressed the pace from outside, moved up on even terms around the bend, vied between runners into the stretch, dueled inside TRAVELIN' SHOW to midstretch and drew clear in the final sixteenth. TRAVELIN' SHOW raced up close outside the top pair, challenged three deep on the turn, put a head in front while drifting in a bit in upper stretch, was overtaken by PRIVATE GEM with a furlong remaining and got turned away in deep stretch. BOLT SUPREMACY angled to the inside stalking the leaders, saved ground through the turn then chased a bit off the rail into the lane, moved out further for the drive, could not summon the needed late kick but was along for the show. GOLDEN RIVER stalked the top pair up the backstretch, went two wide into the turn, eased out and loomed four wide turning for home, overtook CONSTANT CONFLICT in upper stretch and drove clear under right handed urging. CONSTANT CONFLICT dueled outside CANDY'S WILDCAT up the backstretch, inched clear from that rival with a quarter mile remaining, was overtaken by GOLDEN RIVER in upper stretch and stayed on well for a clear second. BLUE SILVER raced in range early, had to be ridden cautiously along the rail lacking room from the half-mile pole to the seven-sixteenths marker, stayed on the fence then moved into the two path at the quarter pole and whittled the gap on the top pair late while picking up the show honors. GIANOLA trailed in the opening stages, traveled four to five wide around the turn and passed tired rivals. CANDY'S WILDCAT fought for the lead head to head inside CONSTANT CONFLICT, failed to keep up with that rival late on the bend and weakened in the drive. PINEAPPLE JUICE settled inside then steered out, went two wide into the turn, angled to the five path around the bend and proved no menace. MOMO'S KIDDO leaned back and hopped at the start, climbed up the backstretch while moving into range, took the turn three then four wide and weakened down the lane. THE STEWARDS REVIEWED THE START OF MOMO'S KIDDO AND RULED THAT HE CAUSED HIS OWN PROBLEMS AT THE START AND IS CONSIDERED A STARTER.

CLEVER CLOVER chased outside a rival off the pace, between foes into the turn, had to wait for room when boxed in midway around the bend, spun three wide into the stretch, kept trying down the lane but could not get by HARCYN for second. SHOP TILL YOU DROP chased the leader from inside into and around the turn, challenged from the fence at the top of the lane, took over shortly after, dueled with THE SHUSHALA through the final furlong while drifting off the fence under left handed urging and dug in to prove best. THE SHUSHALA stalked outside a rival in the early going, took aim two then three wide around the turn, challenged in upper stretch, fought outside SHOP TILL YOU DROP in the furlong grounds and came up a bit short in the end. MOONLIGHT TRYST trailed off the inside, went four wide into the turn, angled in and chased outside a rival in the two path turning for home, then showed a mild response to outkick PUTT FOR DOUGH for the show. PUTT FOR DOUGH tracked outside a rival to the turn, rounded the bend three to four wide, kept trying down the lane but got edged for third. SABRES raced in range in the early going, asked right then left handed while saving ground on the turn and lacked a rally. FEISTY MITOLE sprinted to clear and set the pace up the backstretch, led two wide into the turn, moved in slightly then traveled two wide again into the lane, challenged by a pair of rivals on both sides in upper stretch and folded.

AMELIA BLEU stumbled badly and fell at the start unseating the rider in the process, got back onto her feet quickly and was caught by the outrider shortly after and walked off. THERE WAS A STEWARDS' INQUIRY INVOLVING THE START OF AMELIA BLEU AND RULED THAT SHE CAUSED HER OWN PROBLEMS LEAVING THE GATE AND IS CONSIDERED A STARTER.

ATIA tracked from inside, continued to save ground on the far turn, angled out at the top of the stretch, drew alongside the top pair with a sixteenth remaining and drove clear late. DELIGHTFUL LAURA stumbled leaving the gate, sped clear and raced keenly when taken in hand, took pressure from LEE'S BABY GIRL to the outside, maintained command to the stretch, dueled with that rival to the sixteenth pole, could not match strides with ATIA late and held second. pace in the middle stages, chased three then two wide on the far turn and could not make an impact. AGGRO tracked four then three deep on the clubhouse turn, remained three wide on the far turn and weakened. ALLIHIES traveled two wide then along the rail near the back, saved ground through the far turn and never got involved.

AMORITA displayed good early foot to take command while racing keenly in hand in the two path, controlled the pace to the far turn, took pressure from POLYTHENE PAM at the three-eighths pole, cleared that rival in upper stretch, met bids from RESOLVE AND TAKE ANOTHER CARD in deep stretch and gamely prevailed. RESOLVE rated along the inside, stalked behind the frontrunner through the far turn, coaxed along still on that rivals heels in upper stretch, tipped out at the eighth pole, dug in between rivals late and just missed. FORMULA ROSSA chased off the rial then outside COOEY, ridden along in the two path on the turn then drew alongside the leader in the three path coming into the stretch, quickly put BRILLIANTLY away when asked left handed, drew away under hand urging to the sixteenth pole and coasted late. BRILLIANTLY took control early under pressure from COOEY to the inside, cleared that rival and crossed over, led along the rail then moved to the two path while being confronted by FORMULA ROSSA approaching the stretch, could not offer any resistance and yielded to that rival in upper stretch, then kept on for a clear second. NIKOLINA raced in range early well off the rail, came under a ride while losing ground in the three path around the bend, churned on down the lane and bested the rest. PUTONAHAPPYFACE lacked early speed, saved ground through the turn, tipped out into the lane and improved position. VELOCITY tracked from inside out of range, ridden along the fence then tipped two wide into the lane and lacked a rally. UNWRITTEN CODE showed the way early with TIERGARTEN to the outside, cleared that rival at the half-mile pole, patiently handled along the inside through the turn, given her cue in upper stretch and held well under left handed encouragement. KATERINI tracked three deep to the turn, stayed off the fence to the stretch, loomed from outside with a furlong remaining but finished evenly late. DR. RAY D. reared up in the gate, sat off the pace outside a rival, went two wide into the turn, chased three deep at the quarter pole and showed late interest to gain the show honors. RED DIAMOND broke a step slow, trailed on the inside into the turn, moved to the three path around the bend, tipped out at the top of the lane and improved position. TIERGARTEN pressed the pace early then chased after the leader past the half-mile pole, ridden along two wide through the turn and weakened in the drive. A REAL JEWEL chased between rivals up the backstretch, bumped hard with CHEEKY GAL at the three-eighths pole, continued between runners and brushed with KATERINI at the five-sixteenths pole, went two wide into the stretch and weakened. CHEEKY GAL bumped with inner rival at the start, chased the speed inside a pair of rivals, got bumped hard by A REAL JEWEL and steadied at the three-eighths pole, continued along the fence to the stretch, put to right handed urging but could not rally.
