ATOMIC DROP dueled for the lead inside a rival into the first turn, ceded command and angled off the fence, bid three deep on the far turn, took over at the top of the lane, cleared inner rivals with a furlong remaining and held safely under a drive. DRUIDIC steadied while stalking off the rail late on the first turn, moved to the inside, shifted into the two path around the far turn, moved out in the lane and got up for second. IMPOSSIBLE TASK stalked from inside then moved off the fence and went up to challenge for command leaving the first turn, inched ahead while dueling with inner rival in the middle stages, vied between foes around the far turn, lost command at the top of the lane, could not kick on with the winner past the eighth pole and lost second. LETSHAVEONEMORE dueled from outside into the first turn, cleared inner rival and moved over, headed by IMPOSSIBLE TASK approaching the backstretch, lost command but continue to duel up the backstretch. KING OF CLUBS unhurried in the beginning and moved inside, moved out a bit on the backstretch, swung six wide leaving the far turn, surged from outside to take over in the final fifty yards and drove clear. ANNAN settled early along the fence, went between rivals leaving the backstretch, checked in tight past the five-sixteenths pole, moved out in upper stretch, closed well in the late stages but got outkicked by the winner. MILES FINCH sprinted clear and crossed over, took pressure at the nine-sixteenths pole, cleared again at the half-mile pole, led along the rail through the far turn, challenged by GOING NOWHERE to the inside midstretch, resisted to the sixteenth pole, then yielded to the top pair late. GOING NOWHERE hard to load behind the gate, was closest in pursuit from inside early, chased up the backstretch, saved ground to the lane, rallied up the inside to challenge midstretch but lacked the needed late punch. OM BREW tracked from the two path outside rival, crept closer on the backstretch and moved inside, chased within striking distance down the stretch but finished evenly late. IT'S MY WORLD tucked inside at the back, traveled two then three wide on the far turn, angled five wide late on the bend, cut back in approaching the lane, continued to move to the inside in the lane and failed to threaten while improving position. UNCLE EVCO traveled outside a rival near the back, moved up outside rivals on the backstretch, came back to the two path for the far turn, tipped four wide into the lane, bumped with outer rival at the eighth pole and could not rally. FIGHT BACK reserved in the two path early on, traveled three deep early on the far turn, moved into the two path midway around the far turn, angled five wide into the lane, bumped with inner rival and checked between at the eighth pole and was not persevered with after. SPEED OF ELON pulled and became rank along the inside early, switched off the fence to stalk in the two path, tugged forward to challenge from outside at the nine-sixteenths pole, lost touch with the leader at the midway point but remained close, chased two then three wide on the far turn and retreated down the lane.

ORANGE THUNDER unhurried in the early going and steered to the inside, advanced three then two wide around the far turn, moved out in the lane and rallied under left handed encouragement, drew alongside the top pair late and got up in time. GUILTYOFHAVINGFUN was closest in pursuit of the lone leader from the two path to the far turn, moved to the rail midway around that bend, came off the fence to take aim at the leader, drew alongside in deep stretch and put a head in front late but got nailed by the winner closing from the outside. PRANCINGTHRUPARIS showed good early foot and crossed over to the rail, controlled the pace to the far turn, coaxed along while continuing to save ground on the second bend, led clear under left then right handed urging into deep stretch, challenged by ETERNAL REIGN (IRE) late and was able to hold on. ETERNAL REIGN (IRE) stalked from inside through both turns, roused at the top of the stretch, moved off the fence a bit, latched onto the winner late and kept gaining to the wire but ran out of ground. TIRUPATI stumbled sharply leaving the gate, reserved and taken to the inside towards the rear, traveled between rivals then in the two path on the far turn, produced a mild rally and gained the show honors. CORNELIA FORT tracked in the two path, between rivals leaving the backstretch, ridden along on the far turn, moved out in the lane and finished evenly late. NEEDLEPOINT (IRE) broke a bit slow, traveled in hand at the back, saved ground through the far turn, moved out in the lane and came with a mild rally but could not threaten. LADY MONCLAIRE raced up close in the two path, urged along on the far turn, spun five wide into the lane and lacked a rally. STAR OF THE NIGHT (IRE) unhurried from the gate, began to pull and was rank early, continued to fight the rider around the clubhouse turn and backstretch, saved ground through the far turn and flattened out in the lane. QUICK KATE laid off the pace outside a rival then between foes, trailed outside a rival into the far turn, spen five wide into the four path approaching the first turn then traveled outside a pair of rivals, remained three wide into the far turn, and weakened. MAGIC LIGHT forwardly placed three wide around the clubhouse turn, stayed in the range from the three path to the stretch, then faded out of contention.
