MYSTERIOUS HUSBAND unhurried outside a rival, moved into range three deep on the backstretch, made a move three then two wide on the far turn, took over in upper stretch, dueled inside CUBAN CONFUSION (GB) in the final sixteenth and gamely prevailed. CUBAN CONFUSION (GB) reserved in the two path, drew closer in the middle stages, continue to gain while in the three path around the far turn, drew alongside the top pair inside the eighth pole, dueled from outside in deep stretch and just missed. BROSKI (IRE) accelerated to the front along the inside, controlled the pace to the far turn, confronted by outer rival midway around that bend, resisted to the top of the lane, relinquished the lead outside the eighth pole, then weakened in the last sixteenth. NASSAU CIRCLE rushed up early and became rank into the first turn when trying to rate, was closest in pursuit from the two path, roused around the far turn and also weakened. CANO FOR THE WIN settled next to the fence, tipped two wide late on the far turn and failed to menace.

SMILE BABY SMILE stalked in the two path to the far turn, challenged from outside with three furlongs remaining, took over and cleared approaching the quarter pole, met the challenge from SUPER ELLIE in the stretch and yielded grudgingly late. DORINE'S WILD CAT sat off the pace two then three wide around the first turn, moved further out on the backstretch, gained four deep then three wide on the far turn and flattened out in the lane. BOLD DAUGHTER broke a step slow, reserved in the early going along the inside, drew closer in the middle stages, lost ground next to the fence on the far turn and faded. MOODY JIM (IRE) dropped back and trailed in the opening stages, moved to the inside, exited the turn in the two path then angled out at the top of the stretch, closed in fast, stormed to the front past the sixteenth pole and drove clear. COUNT OF AMAZONIA (IRE) bobbled leaving the gate, raced near the back on the inside, moved into the two path on the turn but lacked room behind rivals near the quarter pole, cut back to the inside, rallied between rivals



midstretch and got up for second. DON'T SWEAR DAVE bumped outer rival in the beginning, chased two wide into the turn, between foes at the five-sixteenths pole, three deep into the lane, rallied into the final furlong, got put in tight at the sixteenth pole, shook off the trouble and kept on to gain second. HACKING IT UP settled along the inside, crept closer around the turn, tipped out into the lane, bid three deep in upper stretch, put a head in front midstretch, then got outkicked by the top trio late. JETOVATOR chased outside a rival early, took an awkward step approaching the five-sixteenths pole, guided out while not being persevered with on the turn, eased in the lane and walked off.

TOUCHDOWN BROWN took control early two wide then along the rail, spurted away on the far turn and remained well clear under right handed urging and steady handling. MOOGIE SON raced in range early in the two path, brushed with outer rival into the far turn, got crowded between rivals past the three-eighths pole, continued to give chase in the two path to the stretch, moved inside in the lane and rallied for second. RODRIGOKNOWS rated three then two wide in the early going, was closest in pursuit two wide then along the rail on the second bend, finished willingly down the lane but got edged for second. FLY THE SKY unhurried in the beginning and steered to the inside, went between rivals on the backstretch, got bumped on both sides at the three-eighths pole, angled to the inside, moved back out in upper stretch and kept on to round out the superfecta. COUSIN RICHIE reserved in the early two to the three wide, tugged the rider along on the backstretch, exited the backstretch three deep between foes, got bumped at the three-eighths pole, hugged the rail to the stretch and weakened. BRAZENLY coaxed from the gate then settled inside, had to pause for a moment at the three-eighths pole, continued along the fence inside several rivals, hit the rail and bumped entering the far turn, had one rival beat into the stretch and passed tired rivals. KEEP MOVIN' ON raced between rivals in the two path off the pace, chased three deep on the far turn and weakened in the lane. SPEED GRAZY was a bit rank briefly after leaving the gate, got put in tight between rivals and steadied shortly after, trailed to menace. SILENT HEAT settled three deep in the opening stages, bumped with inner rival while four deep at the three-eighths pole, trailed three wide into the lane and could not make an impact.
