GRACIE'S BIG DAY stalked four deep up the backstretch then angled into the three path nearing the turn, moved into the two path while creeping up around the bend, lacked room briefly behind the top pair entering the lane, then split foes when finding a seam, put a head in front at the eighth pole, surged clear shortly after and won going away. CIOPPINA PASADINA pressed the pace between rivals outside the leader, fought on even terms around the turn, took the lead entering the lane, fought three deep in upper stretch, lost command at the eighth pole, could not go on with the winner in the furlong grounds and managed to hold second. NOSTRI VIRES pressed the top pair from outside to the turn, chased three wide around the bend, churned on down the lane but could not get by CIOPPINA PASADINA for second. EMPRESS LORRAYNE chased between rivals up the backstretch, bid two wide past the quarter pole, kicked clear upper stretch, led into the final sixteenth but got run down by the winner. HOSER SATRAPA chased four wide into the turn, moved into the three path around the bend, tipped back out to enter the lane in the four path and was along for the show. LUCKY'S SNIPER cleared the field and set the tone up the backstretch off the rail, angled to the inside on the turn, yielded to outer rival in upper stretch and weakened. READY TO DARE tracked off the rail then outside a rival, ridden along two wide around the bend, moved out in the lane and gained second while closing the gap on the winner late. INFINITY DREAM broke in and bumped with MOLLY JENSEN, traveled outside a rival off the pace into the turn, moved out in the lane and gained third. MOLLY JENSEN broke out and bumped, stalked three deep then outside a rival on the backstretch, came under a ride on the turn, was closest in pursuit with a furlong remaining but weakened in the late stages. WILD ROVER LADY (IRE) stalked between rivals then moved inside, fell out of range while saving ground through the turn, cut the corner into the lane and faded. LILLIPUT stalked inside rivals then got put in a bit tight along the rail and lost ground, continued to lose ground next to the fence on the turn and had little left for the stretch run. LUCKY NEA was rank in the early stages at the back, took an awkward step changing leads into the turn, spun three wide off the bend and came up empty. ONWARD AND UPWARD dwelt at the start and came away well behind the field, traveled greenly across the dirt, trailed far back, eased in the stretch and walked off. THERE WAS A STEWARDS' INQUIRY THE START OF ONWARD AND UPWARD AND RULED THAT SHE CAUSED HER OWN PROBLEMS AT THE START AND IS CONSIDERED A STARTER.

EPIONE stalked from inside then eased out to the three path around the clubhouse turn, moved up to apply pressure at the five-eighths pole, dueled around the far turn, led into the stretch, lost command past the eighth pole and weakened late. JUBILANT JOANIE chased two wide into the first turn then steered out to the four path around the bend, remained four wide through the far turn, bid five deep in upper stretch but flattened out in the furlong grounds. MUSCLED stalked from inside, followed out of range on the backstretch, moved into striking distance on the far turn, steered out at the top of the lane, challenged the top pair in upper stretch and quickly took over, put away the inner pair midstretch and lasted over the late charge from the place and show runners. MYTHICAL REEL (IRE) stalked from the two path, dropped off the pace in the middle stages, saved ground through the far turn, angled out and bumped KOKOSAN midstretch, rallied between late and ran out of time. KOKOSAN settled next to the fence, traveled in mid-pack on the backstretch, went outside a rival at the five-sixteenths pole, got bumped from inside midstretch while rallying, closed gamely three deep and came up just short.
