BERT'S PROSPECT reserved in the two path at the back, content to trail into the far turn, looked to gain on the far turn but ran into traffic, swung out past the quarter pole, drifted in while rallying to the front at the sixteenth pole and edged clear. VODKA VODKA stalked inside a pair of rivals to the far turn, tipped out to the two path around that bend, challenged between foes midstretch but got bothered by the winner drifting over at the sixteenth pole and kept on for the place. RHINO dueled for the lead from inside early, ceded command to outer rival leaving the clubhouse turn, closest in pursuit leaving the backstretch, bid two wide and took over at the quarter pole, put away inner rival into the stretch, confronted by a pair of rivals approaching the sixteenth pole and yielded. DEFENSOR FORTIS dueled from outside then cleared late on the first turn, set the pace to the second bend, challenged by RHINO on the far turn, relinquished the lead at the quarter pole and retreated. SPECIAL CLUB stalked between rivals in the two path, suffered a minor shuffle RHINO while boxed in on the backstretch, remained in a bad spot to the far turn, gained a clear path and was roused at the five-sixteenths pole, tipped out three wide and weakened in the stretch run. VOLS stumbled leaving the gate, stalked three deep, got carried wide by the winner past the quarter pole and faded in the lane.

WHIMSICAL HEIR settled outside rivals, drew closer off the inside through the turn, spun three wide into the lane, swept by the leader at the eight pole and widened in the final furlong. KEYCHAIN GIRL set the pace under pressure from YO YO MAMA early, cleared that rival early on the turn, confronted by the winner in upper stretch, offered little resistance and gave up command at the eighth pole, started to shorten in the final sixteenth but managed to hold second. MACHO QUEEN away well in the beginning then dropped back off the pace, chased three then two wide on the turn, steered out in the lane and gained third. WARREN'S WILD RIDE chased from inside in mid-pack, saved ground to the stretch, tipped out at the three-sixteenths pole and kept on for a minor award. YO YO MAMA prompted the pace from outside early, could not match strides with the leader early on the turn, chased two wide into the lane and weakened. CROWN OF HOPE was off slow in the beginning, traveled near the back five wide into the turn, quickly moved into the four path and lacked a rally down the stretch. ZZYZX lacked early speed, trailed along the rail to the stretch, moved out and was never a factor.

THE GIANTS CANDY duelled for the lead off the rail inside a rival then moved inward, cleared outer foe midway around the bend, responded when asked in the lane and drew off while ridden out to the wire. NAISMITH forwardly placed along the inside, chased on the fence to the stretch, moved out a bit in the lane, could not make any headway on the winner but was clearly second best. QUAGMIRE MAGIC tracked off the rail then outside a rival into the turn, rounded the bend two to three wide, steered out in the lane and was along for the show. MOBE TOWN stalked the dueling leaders outside a rival, chased two wide around the bend, could not produce a bid and got outfinished for third. OUTGUNNED angled in while trailing early then went inside a rival on the backstretch, saved ground at the back through the turn and failed to menace. DES DOIGTS held a short advantage dueling for the lead from outside, chased after the winner midway around the bend from the two path and folded in the lane.

RYDER'S CANDY stalked the top trio from outside, angled down to the three path on the turn then came back out approaching the stretch, rallied widest and drove by in the final sixteenth. BESSIE COLEMAN rub the gate and came away very slow to spot the field several lengths, trailed on the inside into the turn, tipped two wide to go around a rival on the turn, moved back inside to rally up the fence and got up for second. RAISING SILVER vied for the lead inside a pair of rivals, regained command at the eighth pole but got outkicked in deep stretch. POTENTIAL SPAM stalked in the three path then dropped back off the pace, gained around the far turn, spun four wide into the lane, bid three deep at the eighth pole and proved best late. BIG DRINKER broke a step slow from outside, chased four then three wide on the first turn, moved to mid-pack on the backstretch, drew closer between rivals, came three wide into the stretch, challenged into the final furlong and got outgamed by the winner. LUTHER PASS away quickly and went up to duel from outside, inched ahead past the five-sixteenths pole, led clear into the lane, clung to a short lead at the eighth pole and yielded in deep stretch. SOLDATNA bumped with inner rival leaving the gate, showed early speed and bumped again with AUDIBLE SILENCE early on the clubhouse turn, dueled inside LUTHER PASS to the second bend, came under a ride to keep up with that rival but lost touch past the quarter pole, then weakened in the final furlong. TOPPERS WAGER hopped at the start, chased along the rail then two wide early, saved ground through the second bend, moved off the fence in upper stretch and weakened. CHROME TO RICHES chased four wide through the first turn, came five wide into the stretch and lacked the needed response. CLASSIC ALPIE was off slow to begin, went three wide into the first turn then altered in from behind a rival, lagged behind up the backstretch, trailed three wide into the lane and passed tired rivals. TAPIT DOWN coaxed from the gate, climbed two to three wide on the first turn, drifted into the lane and could not make an impact. AUDIBLE SILENCE bumped leaving the gate, bumped with same foe again and got put in tight along the rail early on the clubhouse turn, stalked the dueling pair up the backstretch, came three wide into the lane and faded. RUNNING FOR COSI settled inside

well off the pace and failed to get involved.

PHENOM bobbed a bit leaving the gate, went up to duel from inside, cleared outer rival approaching the five-sixteenths pole, drew away in upper stretch, held a diminished lead still unchallenged with a sixteenth remaining and got nailed in the closing moments. PALEO'S PRINCESS broke in and bumped, was closest in pursuit of the top pair in the two path, closed in steadily in the final furlong, put in a late bid and missed second. TEEN DRAMA traveled near the back in the early going, took the turn two wide, steered out at the top of the stretch and summoned a mild rally. YOLO CALLS got bumped from outside in the beginning, settled outside a rival, took the turn two wide, moved out in upper stretch and lacked further response. WOODBINE WAY settled along the inside, cornered nicely into the stretch but lacked a rally in the final furlong. UNWRITTEN CODE sent from the gate and dueled for the lead from outside, failed to keep up with PHENOM around the turn, chased a bit off the rail into the lane and tired. HAND-TIMED.
