WARREN'S SHOWGIRL raced up close four wide on the first turn, pressed the leader from outside in the middle stages, drew on even terms on the far turn, took a short lead late on the bend, put away inner rival entering the stretch but now had to battle with BEAUTIFUL JANET to the outside, fought head to head through the lane and was edged at the wire. CLASSY sped to the front two to three wide inside rivals on the clubhouse turn, showed the way under pressure up the backstretch, dueled around the far turn, chased the top pair into the lane, weakened in the drive but managed to save third. LADY CRUISER was off slow from inside, saved ground through both turns, chased a bit off the rail into the lane and could not threaten while earning a minor award. MISS ALLURE chased five then four wide early, took the second turn three to four wide and failed to rally. MAX'S MAXINE got crowded a bit leaving the gate, went three wide into the first turn then had to check off heels of a rival late on the bend, trailed up the backstretch, passed a tired rival while racing two then three wide on the far turn and was never a factor. STOP DIGGING got crowded between rivals early, stalked outside a rival, took aim two wide entering the lane, challenged in upper stretch and proved best in the final furlong. MIZ CLUBCALI sat off the pace three deep, came in a bit to brush PLAY MY SPEED midway around the turn, had to pause when running into traffic late on the bend, moved off the fence in the lane, rallied but lost his path past the eighth pole, altered inward and finished well for second. SMILING FOREVER dueled for the lead from outside then cleared leaving the backstretch, set the pace to the stretch, challenged in upper stretch, fought to midstretch and yielded in the final sixteenth. DANZINGWITH MAXINE tracked off the rail, spun three wide into the lane and needed to find more late. ISABEL LUDLOW trailed early and moved inside, altered out at the five-sixteenths pole and improved position. LOVELY IDAHO dueled from inside, chased the leader into the turn, saved ground to the stretch and weakened. PLAY MY SPEED sat off the pace, chased between runners into the turn, got forced into inner rival and checked at the five-sixteenths pole and could not recover. SHOOT FOR THE SKY lost path early then settled off the pace, moved closer under coaxing inside a pair of rivals, got bumped and put in tight making him check at the five-sixteenths pole and was not persevered with after. THE STEWARDS DISQUALIFIED MIZ CLUBCALI FROM SECOND TO LAST FOR FORCING PLAY MY SPEED INTO SHOOT FOR THE SKY NEAR THE FIVE-SIXTEENTHS POLE, CAUSING BOTH RIVALS TO CHECK AND COSTING THEM A CHANCE AT A BETTER PLACING.
