ANNIE FOX forwardly placed inside the pacesetter then switch to the outside, chased two wide on the turn, three wide into the lane and weakened. QUEEN GIRVIN tracked the pace three deep, continued off the rail around the bend, spun four wide into the lane

and had little left for the stretch run.
