BROADWAY UNIONS stalked the top pair from outside, took the turn three wide and weakened in the final furlong. SIZE LORD sped clear early then set the pace under pressure at the half-mile pole, dueled with LYELL'S SONG around the bend, yielded to the new leader entering the stretch and gave way. THERE WAS A STEWARDS' INQUIRY INVOLVING THE STRETCH RUN BETWEEN THE TOP TWO FINISHERS. FOLLOWING A REVIEW, THE STEWARDS DISQUALIFIED LYELL'S SONG FROM FIRST TO SECOND FOR DRIFTING OUT AND FORCING HAPPY SPRINTER OFF HIS PATH, COSTING THAT RIVAL A CHANCE AT A BETTER PLACING.

BRIGHT LEAF stalked near the inside, drew closer under coaxing on the far turn, waited for room behind the leaders two wide into the lane, found a seam and split rivals in upper stretch, took over past the eighth pole and held safely. BRAZENLY stalked three deep or four wide on the first turn, ridden along in the three path on the second bend, bid four deep and took over in upper stretch, lost command past the furlong marker and stayed on to the wire. LAMBEAU stumbled leaving the gate, had good early speed along the rail, set the pace under pressure into the backstretch, dueled at the midway point, lost command late on the turn, fought to the eighth pole and weakened in the late stages. DEPARTURE stalked from the two path around the first turn then applied pressure into the backstretch, headed the leader at the half-mile pole, battled around the far turn, carried a short lead into the stretch, lost command shortly after and weakened in the furlong grounds. BIG BUZZ unhurried in the beginning and steered down to the rail, continued at the back into the far turn, eased out to the four path around that bend and was never a factor. TIZ TOK stalked between foes then in the three path on the clubhouse turn, chased two to three wide on the second bend and came up empty when asked.

CLOONEY broke a step slow, chased three wide near the back on the first turn, angled in for the far turn, steered back out past the five-sixteenths pole, spun five wide into the lane, rallied to head the leader at the eighth pole and drew clear. JOHN DUNBAR bobbled a bit at the start, tucked inside early at the back, advanced in hand up the backstretch, asked on the far turn, cut the corner into the stretch, rallied along the fence and got up for second. SOUL OF MIDNIGHT vied for the lead from inside, dueled with AMERICAN CAT past the quarter pole, clung to narrow lead at the eighth pole, relinquished the lead shortly after and got edged for second. MONTANA came away a step slow on the outside, traveled four wide into the first turn hen angled to the inside trailing around the first turn, advanced from inside on the second bend, tipped out into the lane and summoned a mild rally to round out the superfecta. AMERICAN CAT vied four then three deep on the clubhouse turn, continued three deep into the second bend, dueled three wide into the lane and weakened in the furlong grounds. STOP AND A TRES vied between rivals into the first turn then ceded command and stalked in the two path, eased over to



the three path on the far turn, tipped four wide into the lane and flattened. THE BIG WAM broke a step slow, raced wide through the first turn towards the rear, stayed off the rail on the backstretch, rounded the far turn three wide and could not make an impact. FIFTY CINCO vied three then two wide between rivals on the first turn, fought between up the backstretch and around the far turn, lost touch with the leaders past the quarter pole and gave way. EREBUS close up early, stalked four then three wide on the clubhouse turn, remained wide to the stretch and tired. NEVER SEEN BEFORE (IRE) had early speed between rivals and got crowded into the first turn, climbed around the bend, raced mid-pack off the rail on the backstretch, dropped back on the far turn, eased in the lane and walked off.

BALDORO pressed the pace from outside, dueled around the far turn, inched ahead in upper stretch, put away inner rival approaching the sixteenth pole, then had to content with LEGITIMATE TARGE (GB) in deep stretch and held over a surging BIG JUANITO at the wire. BIG JUANITO moved right before the gates opened and came away last, trailed on the inside then went outside a rival on the backstretch, had two beat racing a bit off the rail into the stretch, came out to bother a pair of rivals at the eighth pole, surged late and missed. LEGITIMATE TARGET (GB) bumped on both sides leaving the gate, took a stalking position along the rail, tipped out at the top of the stretch, drew alongside the leader with a sixteenth left to run and could not get by. EMPIRE'S CLASSIC settled along the inside then moved out to the two path while pulling on the clubhouse turn, drew closer on the far turn, came out and bumped rival into the stretch, got forced out by BIG JUANITO past the eighth pole and finished well despite trouble. DEALERS SPECIAL stalked in hand between rivals, remained between foes on the second bend, under a ride entering the lane, moved out in upper stretch, kept on determinedly by was outkicked in the late stages. WHEN HEROES FLY brushed leaving the gate, grabbed the early lead with company to the outside, dueled around the far turn, gave up the lead in upper stretch and weakened in the late stages. TRACKER bobbled and bumped in the beginning, traveled near the back on the inside, eased out to the three path on the final turn and failed to menace. DADDY JUSTIFY unhurried in the opening stages and moved inside, was rank early tossing his head along the rail, remained inside through the far turn and could not make an impact. CHASING RAIN raced in range three deep, went four wide then three wide on the far turn, got bumped and forced out approaching the stretch, then weakened in the final furlong. SHOT OF COURAGE stumbled leaving the gate, stalked outside rivals early, moved outside the top pair leaving the backstretch, chased three deep into the lane, steadied when BIG JUANITO came out at the eighth pole and was not persevered with after. FOLLOWING AN INQUIRY, THE STEWARDS DISQUALIFIED BIG JUANITO FROM SECOND TO FOURTH FOR DRIFTING OUT AND CAUSING INTERFERENCE TO EMPIRE'S CLASSIC IN MIDSTRETCH, COSTING THAT RIVAL A CHANCE AT A BETTER PLACING.
