EARLY ENCORE sprinted clear and showed the way two wide into the turn, found the rail around the bend, given his cue at the top of the lane, widened under strong handling and was in hand approaching the wire. SCAM ALERT chased from inside, shifted to the two path at the quarter pole, kept trying down the lane and outfinished KING KAMEHA for the place honors. KING KAMEHA chased from off the pace three deep leaving the backstretch, went three to four wide into the lane, finished willingly down the lane but got edged for second. POPPI'S CHARLIE chased the leader outside a rival, took the turn two wide and weakened. KEEPSMESANE chased from off the pace on the inside, ridden along around the bend and failed to rally. BABY T was reluctant loading into the gate, lacked early speed, angled to the inside, steered out at the quarter pole, drifted inward in the lane and failed to menace. OLYMPIAN THIRST chased between rivals in the two path into the turn, lost ground around the bend and faded in the drive. SMOKEM WICKED chased four deep out of striking distance early, remained wide to the stretch and also faded.
