LYNDEE'S DREAM fought for the lead from inside, cleared leaving the backstretch, showed the way a bit off the rail into the stretch and held safely under left handed encouragement and steady handling. JACKLYN LUCAS got bumped leaving the gate then had her path taken shortly after, chased from off the pace then moved into range up the backstretch, got bumped and put in tight by BLAME THE TRACK at the five-sixteenths pole, altered out a bit from behind a rival in upper stretch and finished determinedly to edge JOYFUL MISCHIEF for the place honors. JOYFUL MISCHIEF trailed from off the rail in the early going, angled in early on the turn then moved back out and split foes past five-sixteenths pole, driven three wide into the lane, finished well in the final furlong but got outkicked for third. BLAME THE TRACK chased from off the rail then outside a rival leaving the backstretch, looked to advance but lacked room behind a rival and bumped JACKLYN LUCAS at the five-sixteenths pole, continued in the two path to the stretch, kept on down the lane and earned a minor award. LAST CHANCE DARCY bumped with inner rival at the start, dueled from outside then chased two wide into the turn, drifted inward in upper stretch and weakened. AWESOME OLGA raced up close three deep early, chased three then four wide on the turn and tired.
