JOHANNES tracked from the two path early on, ran up on the heels of CABO SPIRIT and checked at the seven-sixteenths pole, continued in the two path through the far turn, tipped three wide leaving the bend, moved out further in upper stretch to launch a bid, drew alongside CABO SPIRIT past the eighth pole, gained the advantage with a sixteenth remaining and drove clear approaching the wire. CABO SPIRIT rated in the two path, crept closer in the middle stages, challenged the top pair from outside and put a head in front on the far turn, carried a short lead into the final furlong, relinquished the lead at the sixteenth pole and held second. ALMENDARES (GB) pulled in the two path behind a rival on the first turn, trailed and moved inside on the backstretch, eased out to the three path around the far turn, moved out further at the top of the lane, finished well in the furlong grounds but could not get by CABO SPIRIT for second. ZIO JO set the pace from inside under pressure, lost command fighting with outer pair on the far turn, stayed on to the sixteenth pole, then weakened late. SCOOBIE QUANDO settled next to the fence at the back, moved into range on the backstretch, ridden along continuing to save ground on the far turn, angled off the fence and kept trying through the final furlong but needed to find more. FINAL BOSS prompted the pace from outside, vied between rivals on the far turn, fought to the eighth pole and weakened.
