JUDE broke inward then trailed up the backstretch, passed rivals along the inside and was on the move gaining around the bend, closed into range and set his sights on the leader in upper stretch, moved off the rail at the eighth pole, reeled in SIMPLE SONG at the sixteenth pole and wong going away. SIMPLE SONG cleared the field and set the pace up the backstretch, remained in front along the inside through the turn, kicked away from a pair of rivals at the top of the lane, got run down by JUDE with a sixteenth remaining and stayed on for a clear second. DOC BOVIE climbed early and dropped back, trailed past the half-mile pole, took the turn three wide and ran on for third. KOKOSAN raced up close from off the rail, roused chasing two wide around the bend and weakened. INTO MIDNIGHT broke in to lose a step, moved up quickly outside KOKOSAN, chased in the three path around the bend and weakened. MUTAZ jumped a shadow early and dropped back off the pace, fell back to last on the turn, eased in the lane and walked off. IMPLACABLE stalked well off the rail up the backstretch, went four wide into the turn, raced three wide leaving the bend, traveled greenly into and upper stretch and tired.
