GAS ME UP trailed in the two path into the turn, tipped three wide at the quarter pole, angled six wide across the dirt, rallied in tandem with SUMTER and bested that rival in deep stretch. SUMTER raced outside a rival from off the pace, rounded the bend in the two path, steered out into the lane, rallied to the front past the eighth pole but was outkicked by GAS ME UP in the late stages. ZIO JO laid off the pace in the two path, steered out crossing the dirt, moved further out into the lane, finished willingly and earned the show honors. EL POTENTE stalked outside a rival approaching the turn, angled to the inside after clearing that runner, eased off the fence and came three wide into the lane, bid three deep in upper stretch but flattened out in the late stages. AWESOME RHYTHM chased four wide into the turn, moved into the three path around the bend, angled five wide approaching the stretch and came up empty.

LEFT HAND MAN trailed two wide early, passed a couple rivals on the backstretch, gained three then four wide on the far turn, challenged in upper stretch, was no match for the winner in the furlong grounds and stayed on to secure second. TEAM PLAYER laid off the pace two to three wide, drew closer on the backstretch, continued two wide on the far turn, finished willingly down the lane and missed second. KEITHING THUNDER raced up close four then three deep around the first turn, bid three deep at the half-mile pole, lost touch with the leaders but remained closer in the three path on the far turn, altered in at the eighth pole and kept on for a minor award. KNOWN IDEA pressed from outside, between rivals at the half-mile pole, fought through the far turn, took over in upper stretch and weakened in the late stages. THE GYPSY COWBOY saved ground near the back, trailed into the far turn, moved off the fence in the lane and improved position. HOUSE OF MISCHIEF stepped to the front and controlled the pace on the inside, met the bid from MEDICI on the far turn, dueled through the lane and finished gamely in defeat. CHARLIE'S CURLIN bumped leaving the gate, stalked on the inside, pulled and shifted out to bump MEDICI on the clubhouse turn, followed next to the fence through the far turn, came

off the rail into the lane, lacked the necessary response but was able to save third. ESSOS broke a bit slow, stalked three deep around the clubhouse turn, remained three wide to the stretch and missed third. KEAGMAN (IRE) settled along the rail, came under a ride on the far turn, cut the corner into the lane and failed to rally. SAHARIAN reserved in the two path, found the rail on the far turn and proved no menace. BIGGIEBIGGIEBIGGIE tracked in the two path, coaxed along around the far turn and weakened down the lane. RIO GRANDE bumped lightly with outer rival at the start, started to pull and became rank early, had to take up behind a rival on the first turn, chased three deep up the backstretch, remained three wide into the lane and could not rally. MENDEL'S TUNE broke a bit slow, coaxed along then got shuffled back when losing a clear path prior to the first turn, trailed next to the rail, raced inside rivals on the backstretch, continued at the back while saving ground to the stretch and passed tired rivals. NEZHA raced three wide near the back into the first turn, got floated out a bit by RIO GRANDE around the bend, returned to the three path, raced outside rivals in the middle stages, tipped out into the lane and was never a factor.
