BILLIE HOLIDAY was closest in pursuit from outside, drew alongside around the bend, took over with a quarter mile remaining, kicked clear at the top of the lane and drew off under right then left handed urging and strong handling late. GOODGOLLYTIZMOLLY hopped slightly at the start, chased along the inside into the turn, moved to the two path then returned to the inside, split foes in upper stretch and gained second but was unable to threaten the winner. GOJE chased on the inside, tipped two wide at the quarter pole, pursued three deep in upper stretch and weakened. MERIDIAN MAE chased outside a rival uup the backstretch and around the bend, came three wide into the lane and weakened. A GREAT SHAKING sprinted clear to set the tone early, took pressure on the turn, lost command at the quarter pole and faded in the stretch run. GOGOTIZ trailed up the backstretch, went two then three wide around the bend and was never a factor.
