LUMINOUS BEAUTY broke very alertly then sped clear, dictated terms in the two path through the turn, cruised into upper stretch under her own power, responded well when asked at the three-sixteenths pole, extended the advantage under a strong-hand ride into the final furlong, was given one light pop of a right-handed crop outside the sixteenth-pole and powered away while put to a mild hand-ride late. MARGIE'S GIRL was urged along off the pace, angled in near the nine-sixteenths pole, dropped to the rail nearing the turn, saved ground going around that bend, was put to the crop in the two path at the quarter-pole and proved no match for the winner while just able to get the place. MEL WENT HOME sat back some at the start and was last away, settled off the pace while the only contestant not under urging, saved ground while put to light coaxing on the turn, was roused at the quarter-pole and finished willingly but missed the place while well clear for the show. MINDEE'S WORLD brushed the inside of the gate at the start then was hustled, chased the pace on the outside, went around the turn in the four then three path and weakened. DINNER PARTY chased the pace on the outside from second, went around the turn in the three to four path and tired. SAYSOMETHINGNICE was ridden along on the outside, dropped from the five path to the four path early on the turn, spun into the stretch in the five path and failed to threaten. SO ANGELINA brushed with a rival early, was ridden along on the outside, traveled around the turn in the three path and failed to respond. BIBLICAL JUSTICE brushed with an opponent early, moved in while urged at the rear, saved ground on the turn and was no factor.

GOODALL buckled at the break, raced four paths off the inside down the backstretch before tucking to the two path into the turn, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths marker, had the rider switch the crop from the left to right hand and lost the handle on it swinging four wide into upper stretch, rallied to take command a furlong out, edged clear under a drive to score. CARMEL COAST stumbled and brushed the off side stall at the start before bumping OSCAR BOUND, came under brief urging and established the front near the five furlong pole, showed the way in hand just off the inside down the backstretch and then along the inside through the turn, spun just off the inside into upper stretch under threat from a pair of foes to the outside, dug in and was collared at the eighth pole, kept on to the wire to preserve the place honors by a head. MYTHICAL broke out at the break and was corrected, chased five paths off the inside down the backstretch just off the top pair, tucked three wide through the turn and came under urging with five-sixteenths to go, angled five wide into upper stretch, kept on under a drive and missed for the place honors while clear for the show. PAIGE TURNER bobbed at the break, chased five paths off the rail down the backstretch and then three wide through the turn ridden along with five-sixteenths remaining, angled four to five wide at the head of the stretch and made no late headway. IRISH JIG six paths off the inside down the backstretch in pursuit from the tail of the field, steadily tucked inwards to be just off the inside with three-eighths to run, angled out four to five wide into upper stretch, shied out under a left handed crop straightened away three to four paths, then got corrected under a right handed crop and shied inwards three paths while tiring through to the finish. OSCAR BOUND got bumped at the start by CARMEL COAST, who recovered outwards from a stumble, chased three then two wide under a ride from three furlongs out, continued two to three wide at the head of the stretch, tired.

Following an eleven minute delay due to a late scratch and the attending to of a rider by medical personnel, DIRECTIVE raced three then two wide through the first turn, attended the leader to the outside two to three paths off the rail down the backstretch before tucking to the two path through the far turn, came under coaxing just outside the quarter pole and tipped four wide into upper stretch, shied out slightly straightened away, seized command with three-sixteenths to go, edged away briefly and drifted out a furlong out appearing a bit green, then drifted out once more near the tracks of the gate inside the sixteenth marker under growing threat to the inside, got righted with forty yards to the finish and held safe to prevail. MEASURE got tapped at the start by CHIT CHAT due to pressure from U LITE UP MY LIFE, saved ground near the rear of the field, was in behind CHIT CHAT nearing the quarter pole and got forced to pause in behind that rival at that station before cutting the corner into upper stretch as that foe took to the three path, closed in through the final furlong under a drive to secure the place honors. Following the repair of a broken bridle in the gate prior to the start, U LITE UP MY LIFE broke out at the start bumping CHIT CHAT who make light contact with MEASURE, established the front and showed the way in hand along the inside and was patiently handled through moderate splits, got roused taking the inside route into upper stretch, dug in and was caught at the three-sixteenths, kept on to preserve the show honors while well clear of the rest. CARELESS WHISPER broke in a step at the start and was bumped by SUITED CONNECTORS due to pressure from LAKE ARIEL, established the front after the start and showed the way in hand along the inside and then just off the inside coming under coaxing near the quarter pole, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, went clear under a drive and was geared down in the late stages. NAVY SEAL (IRE) tracked the pace along the inside from a loose pocket through the opening half mile, took closer order past the stands the second time before shifting two to three wide through the third turn, angled three to four paths off the rail down the backstretch the second time before tucking to the two path through the final turn advancing on the leader to take over under coaxing with five-sixteenths to go, spun three wide into upper stretch, dug in under lone threat to the outside and was caught just outside the eighth pole, ran on willingly to the wire. MIZTERTONIC tracked along the inside from near the rear of the field early on, tipped out two to three wide and began an advance the second time down the backstretch, went three wide through the far turn coming under urging nearing the quarter pole, angled five wide into upper stretch, weakened in the late stages while clear for the show honors. FLASHIEST struck the off side stall at the start, raced just off the inside at the tail of the field through the opening mile, tipped out three wide through the third turn and then three to four paths off the inside down the backstretch the second time through, went four wide through the last turn and then six wide into upper stretch bidding into prominence at the head of the stretch, then weakened in the stretch. CORRUPTION raced forwardly placed three wide through the first turn, settled just off the inside in closest aim of the leader through the opening mile before advancing and taking over just under the wire the second time, showed the way in hand just off the inside until tucked to the fence into the last turn and came under pressure to the outside, relinquished the front with five-sixteenths to go, took the inside route into upper stretch and was eased home through the final furlong, galloped out and returned and was unsaddled, then collapsed in the walk back and was attended to and vetted returning to his feet and was walked off under his own power. FLEETFOOT (IRE) raced in mid pack early on before advancing to settle just off the top pair while three wide through the first and second turns, chased three then two wide coming under coaxing three furlongs out, cornered three then two wide into upper stretch, folded, and was eased home to the wire. CONCORD GREEN two to three wide between foes in pursuit from mid pack, raced three to four wide through the final mile and both remaining turns, went four wide for home, gave way and was eased home to the finish. WORTHINGTON established the front and showed the way under a light hold along the inside through the opening mile, got headed for the front just under the wire the second time and steadily faded through the second mile coming under a drive five furlongs out, continued to retreat and swung three to four wide into upper stretch, faltered, and was eased home to the end. Please note the split for a mile and three-quarters was not available.

MO COMPLEX stalked the pace on the outside in the two path, engaged the leader on the far turn, took the advantage in the three path at the quarter-pole then came out a bit more, shook clear outside the furlong marker, responded well into the final sixteenth and held under steady urging. RIVER TAY (IRE) saved ground while reserved near the back, moved off the rail while behind horses around the five-sixteenths pole, remained behind horses in the three path into upper stretch then was roused, split foes in the vicinity of the furlong marker and finished well to just get the place. PRETTY LAVISH (IRE) was well placed while rated just off the pace on the inside, moved off the rail late on the far turn, came out to the five path into upper stretch, pursued the winner to the finish and showed good courage for the show. DIVIDEND RECAP bumped with an opponent at the start then steadied off heels, raced in the three path on the first turn, settled off the pace, was roused in the four path on the far turn, turned into upper stretch in the six path and finished with good energy to just miss the show. AUTONOME dropped back just after the start then angled in, traveled around the first turn in the two path, settled at the rear, was roused in the two then three path on the far turn, came out to the seven path into upper stretch and improved position. HEAVENLY LIGHT went to the front, showed the way in hand on the inside, was asked outside the quarter-pole, lost the advantage into upper stretch and gave way. LOTUS PETAL tucked in early, was reserved in the two path, came under a drive on the far turn and lacked the needed response. BOBBY JEAN bumped with a foe at the start then was grabbed with the right rein, saved ground on both turns and failed to threaten. HAUNTRESS went around the first turn in the three path, was reserved off the pace, rounded the far turn in the three path while asked, spun into the stretch in the four path and failed to rally. RACING COLORS rounded the first turn in the two path, was reserved off the pace, moved from the two path to the four path under urging on the far turn, came into upper stretch in the eight path and also failed to rally. PRINCESS SUMMER raced in the three path on the first turn, settled towards the rear, was urged along in the four to five path on the far turn and was no factor. LADY RIVER LILY broke a bit awkwardly, tucked from the four path to the three path early on the first turn, settled near the middle of the field, was roused in the three path on the final turn and failed to respond.
