MY GUN'S LOADED broke in at the start and was corrected, chased along the inside and then just off the inside coming under coaxing near the quarter pole before being set down swinging five to six wide into upper stretch, rallied to take command just inside the three-sixteenths pole, then edged clear to the finish to score. COLD SPELL lost her lane at the start when FUSION recovered inwards from a bobble, chased four then three wide under a ride from the five-sixteenths marker, swung four wide into upper stretch taking over command straightened away, got collared just inside the three-sixteenths pole, then ran on to preserve the place honors while no match for the top one. PIPPA ADDS chased along the inside, angled out three to four wide into upper stretch in behind rivals roused for the drive, dug in and angled in to the two path a furlong out, kept on to the finish. CROWNING GLORY chased five paths off the rail down the backstretch and then three wide through the turn under a ride with seven-sixteenths to go, angled six wide into upper stretch and passed tired rivals to the wire. MY SHERRONA prompted the pace of NAKOMA from the outside three then two wide coming under coaxing when taking command near the quarter pole, spun three wide into upper stretch, yielded the front to COLD SPELL straightened away and tired. FUSION bobbed at the break and recovered inwards to take over the lane of the slower breaking COLD SPELL, chased three wide and faded down the backstretch tucking to the two path into the turn, spun just off the inside into upper stretch and tired. NAKOMA hustled from the gate, cut the pace just off the inside coaxed along lightly under some pressure from MY SHERRONA to the outside, tucked inside through the turn and came under urging midway, yielded the front nearing the quarter pole, took the inside route into upper stretch, tired, and was eased in the late stages to the end.

SENIOR OFFICER stalked the pace on the outside, was asked in the three path on the turn, chased the runner-up under a drive into the final furlong, gained into the final sixteenth and got up in the final stride to narrowly prevail. CONTRARY THINKING angled in while going to the front then showed the way, vied inside on the turn, responded well when asked near the quarter-pole, came under a left-handed crop in upper stretch, was switched to a right-handed crop while drifting out some coming to the sixteenth-pole, led until the final stride but was denied while clear for the place. LIFE AND TIMES broke in and bumped with a foe then dropped back, settled on the inside of an opponent, was roused in the two then three path on the turn, came into the stretch in the four path and lacked the needed kick while up for the show. RESILIENCE was well placed while rated just off the pace, saved ground on the turn, was asked at the quarter-pole then moved out, chased under a drive into the final furlong and weakened. AWESOME NATIVE settled on the outside, was roused in the three then four path on the turn, spun into the stretch in the five path and lacked the needed response. PARADISE VALLEY tossed his head at the start, was bumped and forced in then dropped back, settled at the rear, saved ground under urging on the turn, steadied behind horses coming to the quarter-pole, was roused into upper stretch and failed to threaten. INCENTIVE PAY was a bit awkwardly into stride, settled towards the rear, was roused in the two path on the turn, moved to the three path late on that bend, turned into the stretch in the five path, shifted in outside the furlong marker and failed to respond. COMMUTED prompted the pace on the outside of the leader, chased the pace late on the backstretch, went around the turn in the two path, dropped back coming to the quarter-pole and faltered then was eased in the final furlong but walked off.

BONUS MOVE stumbled at the break, showed the way in hand along the inside through moderate splits settled into a comfortable rhythm and patiently handled through to the quarter pole, got roused spinning three wide into upper stretch, dug in under growing threat from flanking challengers inside the eighth pole and held gamely to the finish to prevail. EJTIMAA broke out at the start bumping CIAO CHUCK, saved ground at the tail of the field, came under coaxing near the quarter pole and angled three to four wide into upper stretch, closed in through the drive surging late and just missed at the finish. CIAO CHUCK bobbed slightly at the break and was bumped by EJTIMAA, chased along the inside patiently handled, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, got roused straightened away, rallied along the inside to issue a challenge inside the final furlong but was ultimately repelled to the wire. INTELLECT (FR) settled tracking the leader in closest aim in the clear to the outside in the two path, came under encouragement with five-sixteenths to go, angled four wide into upper stretch and stayed on one paced to the finish. SON OF A BIRCH pulled eagerly off the heels of INTELLECT early on resisting the restraint of the rider mouth agape until able to settle into the backstretch, tracked the front from near the rear of the field under a light hole until placed to urging nearing the quarter pole, angled out six to seven wide into upper stretch, offered up a bid but was outkicked. CANDYTOWN raced three wide through the first turn, chased three wide on hold until let out angled six wide into upper stretch, then weakened in the late stages.

NYSOS got bumped at the start by VIBE, who broke in a step, raced along the rail leading early on before coming under pressure from a pair nearing the backstretch, vied inside a pair of rivals with KNIGHTSBRIDGE in close attendance latched on the trio to the outside, eased off those rivals with five and a half furlongs to go and chased along the inside through to the three-eighths marker when tipped out two then three wide briefly before heading back to the two path at the five-sixteenths placed to encouragement, angled six wide into upper stretch rallying to engage the top pair and took command three-sixteenths from home, then edged clear to the finish to score. GOLDEN TEMPO broke out awkwardly brushing the off side stall at the start, settled unhurried saving ground at the tail of the field, steadily tipped to the two path near the half mile pole, briefly went three wide into the turn before heading back to the two path as COMMANDMENT nudged him back in, came under coaxing near the five-sixteenths and began to angle out bumping COMMANDMENT and nudging that rival out while heading seven to eight wide into upper stretch, rallied in tandem with that rival to overthrow the front a furlong out, dug in under a drive and traded a brush with COMMANDMENT a sixteenth from home, then edged away to the finish to score. COMMANDMENT three wide through the first turn, chased four paths off the inside down the backstretch, continued four wide into the far turn and briefly tucked three wide nudging GOLDEN TEMPO from the three path to the two path, came under coaxing at the three-eighths marker, had GOLDEN TEMPO lean out and was bumped then nudged five wide just inside the five-sixteenths pole, continued outwards to swing eight to nine wide into upper stretch, drifted in rallying in concert with the aforementioned foe to overhaul the front a furlong out, dug in and traded a brush at the sixteenth marker, got shaken off inside that station while fighting on to the end. RENEGADE bobbed at the break, raced just off the inside through the first turn before heading three paths off the rail down the backstretch, continued three wide through the far turn coming under urging with five-sixteenths to go, angled six wide into upper stretch, dug in rallying with the top pair to the furlong grounds, then couldn't keep pace late and was shaken off by those rivals while keeping on to be clear for the show honors. GROWTH EQUITY forwardly placed from the gate, prompted the leader from the outside three wide through the first turn and then three paths off the inside down the backstretch, continued three wide into the far turn, tucked to the two path when POWERSHIFT took to the rail at the three-eighths pole, then tucked in front of that rival when seizing narrow command impeding him and forcing him to check just inside the five-sixteenths marker and for VITRUVIAN MAN to steady in behind POWERSHIFT, took the inside route now in front and under threat to the outside, relinquished the lead with three-sixteenths to go and weakened through to the wire. VITRUVIAN MAN raced just off the pace two to three wide, tucked inside nearing the three-eighths pole and was steadied off the heels of POWERSHIFT tucked to the rail, the rider nearly standing up, then got steadied once more at the five-sixteenths pole when POWERSHIFT was impeded directly in front at that station by GROWTH EQUITY, swung three wide into upper stretch and tired. SOUNDS LIKE A PLAN showed speed on the outside, rounded the first turn in the two path, moved to a solo lead with five furlongs to run, raced inside on the far turn, responded well when asked for his best in upper stretch and held under strong urging. FAVORABLE SCENARIO was taken back under a strong hold while in tight between horses nearing the first turn, saved ground off the pace, pursued the winner under a drive in the stretch and willingly earned the place. WINNEBAGO (IRE) settled on the inside, was roused on the far turn and finished with late energy to just miss the place while clear for the show. BLOWN COVER showed speed on the inside of a foe, raced inside on the first turn, dropped just off the pace, was asked along the hedge on the far turn and lacked the needed kick. ELNAJD broke out and bumped with a rival, jostled with GRIFFIN'S WHARF near the seven-eighths pole, rounded the first turn

in the two path, was rated just off the pace, moved from the two path to the three path on the far turn, lost his footing and stumbled inside the five-sixteenths pole and had the rider lose his left iron, moved out soon thereafter, saw the rider reach down to regain his boot in the stirrup in upper stretch and lacked the needed response. DOUBLE ACT went around the turns in the two then three path and failed to rally. NOBLE FACTOR saved ground at the rear, moved off the hedge late on the far turn, swung well out into upper stretch then drifted out under a left-handed crop, switched to a right-handed crop inside the furlong marker and failed to threaten. OUTFUNNER stumbled at the start then bumped with a rival, steadied briefly in tight between horses early, rounded the first turn in the three path, stalked the pace on the outside, was asked in the two to three path on the far turn and came up empty. FORTUNE SELLER angled in early, raced in the two path on the turns and failed to respond. GRIFFIN'S WHARF bumped with rivals at the start, jostled with ELNAJD nearing the first turn then was taken in hand, went around the turns in the two three path and also came up empty. RAMBLIN' WRECK stumbled at the start, raced towards the rear while in the two to three path on the turns, stumbled significantly coming to the quarter-pole and was taken up then never reached contention. FIRST CALL BOB settled on the inside, came up empty on the far turn and dropped out.
