ALL OF IT tracked the pace along the inside coming under coaxing with five-sixteenths to go, spun three wide into upper stretch, rallied to take command just inside the eighth pole, drew clear under a drive to prevail. CONSIDERATE CITY saved ground in pursuit from mid pack, came under urging three furlongs from home, continued in the inside route into upper stretch, angled out nearing the sixteenth marker and ran on to secure the place honors in the final jumps. BERTRILLE three then two wide through the first turn, chased three then two wide under a ride with five-sixteenths remaining, angled five wide into upper stretch, kept on to improve position and procure the show honors. NESHIKA raced just off the inside in closest aim of the leader, tucked inside at the seven-sixteenths marker, got roused spinning just off the inside into upper stretch, dug in prominent to the furlong grounds, weakened in the late stages. BRYANT AND COOPER struck the near side stall at the start and was away last, settled just off the inside at the tail of the field, came under encouragement tipping out three then four wide at the five-sixteenths marker, went seven wide into upper stretch and passed tired rivals to the finish. BOOMINGTON chased just off the inside under a ride from the seven-sixteenths, continued just off the inside into upper stretch, offered up mild late foot making some ground late. TONGUE TWISTER established the front after the start and showed the way in hand along the inside, shook away midway on the far turn, got set down taking the inside route into upper stretch, dug in under threat and was caught just inside the eighth pole, then weakened to the finish. ON A SUMMER DAY chased three then two wide under a ride with five-sixteenths remaining, tipped four wide into upper stretch, offered no response. QUICK POWER NAP four then three wide through the first turn, chased three wide under urging from the five-sixteenths pole, angled five to six wide into upper stretch, had no kick. TAHILA chased along the inside under a ride from the five-sixteenths marker, spun three wide for home, made no impact.

NEW YORK SPECIAL moved from the hedge to the two path on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, drafted in the two path on the far turn, was asked with room at the quarter-pole, made a bid inside of the runner-up in upper stretch, dueled inside of that foe to the finish and gamely prevailed. MORNING PRAYER was hustled from the gate and established a forward position, dropped from the three path to the two path on the first turn, stalked the pace on the outside, turned up the pressure in the two to three path on the far turn, was asked near the quarter-pole, dueled outside of the winner in the stretch and was denied while clear for the place. FACTORY SETTING went around the first turn in the four path, was reserved off the pace, rounded the far turn in the four path while roused, came into the stretch in the six path, swapped back to her inside lead at the furlong marker and improved for the show. AMAZING GRACER bobbled at the start, angled in at the rear of the field, saved ground on the first turn, settled at the rear while outside on the backstretch, was roused in the five then six path on the far turn and improved for the last spot in the superfecta. SOARING SPIRIT was off slow, angled in early, tugged keenly on the bit into the first turn, raced in the three path on that bend, was reserved off the pace, traveled around the far turn in the three path while still under restraint, was asked briefly outside the quarter-pole then paused behind horses, came under urging into upper stretch then angled out and also

improved position. ZAP THAT GHOST dropped back early, moved from the three path to the two path on the first turn, was unhurried near the rear, shifted from the two path to the four path on the far turn and lacked the needed response. FORCE OF MISCHIEF broke out at the start, raced inside on the first turn, dropped back under restraint late on that bend and early on the backstretch, raced just off heels with five furlongs to run, saved ground on the far turn, moved to the two path coming to the quarter-pole and failed to impact. NO TIDE was hustled from the gate, became rank in the two path on the first turn, was rated off the pace, traveled around the far turn in the two then three path, spun into the stretch in the four path and failed to threaten. NO NEED TO PANIC went around the first turn in the four path, was rated towards the front, chased in the three path on the far turn and tired. PELICAN PRIDE stumbled awkwardly at the start, became rank under restraint early, tugged hard on the bit in the three path on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, rounded the far turn in the four then five path while roused and failed to rally. COACH OF THE YEAR broke a bit awkwardly then was hustled, saved ground while well placed and rated just off the pace, chased inside on the far turn and came up empty. SAINT MARGARET went to the front, raced off the hedge on the first turn, showed the way down the backstretch, vied inside on the far turn, was asked near the quarter-pole, lost the advantage near the three-sixteenths pole and gave way.

COMPLEX AGENDA brushed the off side stall at the start, established the front just after the break and showed the way in hand along the inside through moderate splits hounded by GENE AND JUDE to the outside at times engaged in head to head combat, remained patiently handled until set down spinning three wide into upper stretch, dug in under threat from a pair of foes and fended them both off holding gamely and stubborn to the wire. THE PADDOCK PASTOR raced three then two wide through the first turn, chased three then four wide coming under a ride at the five-sixteenths pole, angled five wide into upper stretch, rallied to stack outside the top pair a furlong out, dug in under a drive fighting gamely to the wire but was ultimately denied on the line. GENE AND JUDE prompted the leader from the outside two to three wide at times dueling the with the top one down the backstretch and through the far turn, came under coaxing near the quarter pole and swung four wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive and ran on to the finish unable to match the top pair in the very late stages while preserving the show honors at the finish. SALT SPARTAN chased along the inside coming under a ride near the quarter pole, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, kept on to the end. BRIDLE A BUTTERFLY saved ground in pursuit from mid pack coming under encouragement with five-sixteenths to go, spun three wide for home and improved position through to the finish. FINAL DENILE broke open the stall door prior to the start, the assistant starter keeping a strong hold in a good effort to keep this charge within the gate, chased along the inside patiently handled until roused spinning three to four wide for home, angled out a sixteenth out and stayed on one paced to the wire. MO KREESA broke out at the start bumping THREE PERCENT, chased two to three wide under a ride from the five-sixteenths pole, angled four to five wide into upper stretch and weakened in the late stages.
