MCAFEE coaxed from the gate, showed the way in hand just off the inside through the first turn and then three paths off the rail down the backstretch, tucked inside half a mile from home, came under coaxing at the three-eighths pole, spun just off the inside into upper stretch and drew off under a drive to prevail. CHILLAX coaxed from the start, raced just off the inside into the first turn forwardly placed between foes and was eased off near seven and a half furlongs to run to chase two then three paths off the inside down the backstretch, briefly tucked inside into the far turn before angling back out three wide when placed to urging three furlongs out, angled five wide into upper stretch, proved no match for the top one and kept on to preserve the place honors on the wire. PRETTY BOY MIAH hustled from the gate, raced three wide through the first turn, prompted the leader from the outside four paths off the rail down the backstretch and then just off the inside through the turn under encouragement with five-sixteenths to go, spun three wide into upper stretch, got shaken off straightened away and weakened in the late stages while clear for the show honors. NOGRADI raced along the rail through the opening turn before tipping four paths off the rail down the backstretch, tucked three then briefly two wide when placed to urging at the seven-sixteenths marker, went back three wide midway on the turn and then seven wide into upper stretch and weakened. FOUNDERS coaxed from the start, chased just off the inside through the first turn and then five paths off the inside down the backstretch, tucked three wide at the half mile pole before heading four wide midway under a ride from the seven-sixteenths pole, tipped five to six wide into upper stretch and tired. COPIOUS coaxed from the gate, raced four wide through the first turn, chased five paths off the rail down the backstretch before heading four wide through the far turn ridden along from three furlongs out, went eight wide into upper stretch and tired. FACT coaxed from the start, raced three wide through the first turn and then six paths off the inside down the backstretch, tucked five then four wide through the far turn, angled eight to nine wide into upper stretch and tired.

ALLURA showed speed then set the pace, vied inside on the turn, came off the rail while asked for her best in upper stretch, responded gamely under threat in the final furlong, swapped back to her inside lead late and just held under strong urging. ROCKABYE was hustled from the gate, chased the pace on the outside then in the two path on the turn, pursued the winner while further out in the course in upper stretch, gained to make a bid near the sixteenth-pole, fought outside the winner to the finish and just missed while clear for the place. GIRLS WEAR PEARLS bumped with a rival early while brushing with another foe, was rated under restraint, went around most of the turn in the three path while let out then moved to the four path, gained in the five path into the stretch, chased outside into the final furlong and weakened but earned the show. CHARLOTTE'S BEACH brushed with a rival early, was well placed just off the pace, dropped back a bit leaving the backstretch, moved from the rail to the three path while roused on the turn, spun into upper stretch in the four path then chased further out in the course, raced between horses into the final furlong, dropped back into the final sixteenth and also weakened. PAVLOVA'S PALACE (GB) hit the inside of the gate and was last to commence, was urged early then had the rider fall back in the saddle briefly, settled last but one, saved ground on the turn, moved to the two path outside the quarter-pole, angled out in upper stretch and lacked the needed response. TIMBERTOP bumped with a rival early then dropped back, went around the turn in the two path and failed to threaten. BOURBON MADNESS was hustled from the gate, dropped well behind under urging, rounded the turn in the two path and was no factor.

ANYWAY coaxed from the gate, came out slightly brushing LIBERTY RISING, raced briefly in the two path behind a rival and tipped out bumping FIREBALLIN at the nine-sixteenths marker and taking over the three path, pressed the pace of B PROVOCATEUR from the outside coming under a ride with five-sixteenths to go, swung four wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive taking command just outside the eighth pole, then edged away to the finish kept to task. B PROVOCATEUR showed the way in hand just off the inside coming under coaxing near the quarter pole, spun two to three wide into upper stretch, dug in under threat and was caught just outside the eighth pole, dug in and ran on to preserve the place honors by a nostril on the wire. MO FOR THE KING broke out at the start brushing LIBERTY RISING, chased along the inside down the backstretch before tipping out three then four wide coming under a ride at the three-eighths pole, angled six wide into upper stretch and ran on to just miss for the place honors on the line. LIBERTY RISING bobbed at the break and was brushed between foes, chased six paths off the rail early on until tucked to the two path half a mile from home, chased just off the inside through the turn and into upper stretch, weakened in the drive. THE TOY CANNON broke out at the start, chased five paths off the inside in the early stages, got carried out three paths to be eight paths off the rail when FIREBALLIN was under a protective hold and being guided outside nearing the half mile pole, had that rival allow him to get by so as not to continue outwards with him, quickly tucked four then three and two wide by the three-eighths marker, tipped back four wide at the quarter pole and weakened in the stretch. FIREBALLIN chased three to four paths off the inside forward from the start, got bumped by ANYWAY at the nine-sixteenths marker and was pushed out, tossed his head rank and appearing in distress, got quickly placed to a protective hold and was guided outside taking THE TOY CANNON with him outwards three paths before allowing that rival to get by and escape being carried out any further, was expertly eased up and then pulled up in the vicinity of the seven-sixteenths marker, got attended to and vetted and was subsequently transported off the course via the equine ambulance.

TO A FLAME established a forward position early, raced in the two path on the first turn, was rated just off the pace, drafted inside while behind the leader on the far turn, waited a touch into the stretch then shifted to the three path, rallied outside into the final furlong, closed powerfully to get the lead just inside the sixteenth-pole and prevailed under good handling.
