COMMERCE coaxed from the gate to the front, dueled early through the first turn with PRESIDENTIAL POWER to his outside, took sole command six and a half furlongs out and showed the way narrowly in hand along the inside, had that rival advance once more into the far turn and knocked heads through to the five-sixteenths, got roused spinning just off the inside into upper stretch, edged away to the eighth pole, held sway to the finish kept to task. PRESIDENTIAL POWER raced three wide through the first turn dueling early on for command, settled three then two wide in closest aim of the top one coming under coaxing three furlongs out when advancing to issue a challenge midway on the far turn, swung four wide into upper stretch, kept on to secure the place honors. PAUILLAC coaxed from the gate, raced three wide through the first turn, then chased two then three wide under prolonged coaxing from the half mile pole, angled six wide into upper stretch, weakened in the late stages. ASKED AND ANSWERED chased just off the inside and then along the inside under a ride from three furlongs out, swung three to four wide into upper stretch, tired. SORRENTINO coaxed from the start, went four wide through the first turn, then chased three then two wide under prolonged urging from the half mile pole, took the inside route into upper stretch and tired.
