JORDAN'S LOVE broke out then was corrected by the rider, went around the first turn in the two path, settled outside but with cover, was roused in the three then four path on the far turn, rallied outside into upper stretch, closed strongly to make a bid outside the furlong marker then battled outside of two foes, came in ever so slightly coming to the sixteenth-pole, fought with the runner-up to the finish and narrowly prevailed under strong urging. FELIXYN went to the front, showed the way on the inside while inside of an opponent, was asked on the far turn, shook off a rival under a drive in upper stretch, fought inside of two foes under a right-handed crop from the furlong marker, came out a bit when switched to a left-handed crop at the sixteenth-pole which put GUM in a sticky situation, fought gamely with the winner to the finish and was denied while clear for the place. GUM saved ground while reserved off the pace, was roused late on the far turn, tipped to the two path in upper stretch, gained to make a bid between the top two into the final furlong, checked in tight quarters at the sixteenth-pole and lost any chance while clear for the show. U VICKY saved ground on the first turn, settled at the rear, was asked in the two path on the far turn, spun into the stretch in the three path, angled out near the three-sixteenths pole and improved for the last spot in the superfecta. RESORT (FR) was taken under a tight hold early then rated on the inside, came under urging on the far turn, moved to the two path late on that bend, spun into the stretch in the three path and weakened. LOVEONTHELEFTBANK showed speed on the outside of an opponent, raced in the two path on the first turn, prompted the pace on the outside, was given her cue in the two path on the far turn, dropped back in upper stretch and tired. EPIC SELLOFF stumbled significantly at the start, saved ground towards the rear of the field, was urged along late on the backstretch, continued inside through the far turn and lacked the needed response. PRIVATE PROPERTY (IRE) was taken under a tight hold early, rounded the first turn in the two path, was rated outside but with cover, came under encouragement in the three path on the far turn, turned into upper stretch under a drive and failed to rally. FOLLOWING A STEWARDS' INQUIRY INTO THE STRETCH RUN, NO CHANGE WAS MADE TO THE ORDER OF FINISH
