THE GOOD LIFE broke in at the start brushing GOT TOUGH, established the front soon after and showed the way in hand just off the inside patiently handled through swift splits, got set down spinning just off the inside into upper stretch, drew off under a drive to the eighth pole, then got ridden out through the final sixteenth to the finish to score. POWERLINE coaxed from the start, grew rank facing kickback from JOHNNY HOCKEY down the backstretch tossing his head loosely between foes to the half mile pole, tucked to the two path into the turn before making his way to the rail three furlongs out forcing GOT TOUGH to very briefly take hold, came under urging near and spun just off the inside at the quarter pole and got bumped solidly straightened away by JOHNNY HOCKEY, who was directed in in a premature attempt to switch leads, offered up a mild kick to chase the winner home clear of the rest and along second best. GOT TOUGH got brushed at the break by THE GOOD LIFE, chased just off the inside and then along the inside coming under a ride near the quarter pole, swung four wide into upper stretch, angled in one path near the eighth pole, then got carried in by GREENWELL to the rail and improved position to secure the show honors on the wire. JOHNNY HOCKEY broke on top coaxed from the gate, chased three wide coming under a ride from the three-eighths marker, swung three wide at the quarter pole and then came in under an active left rein and bumped POWERLINE solidly just inside the quarter pole in an attempt to switch leads before straightening away, dug in under a drive and weakened in the late stages. GREENWELL coaxed from the gate, bobbed a few strides after the start, chased four then three wide under a ride with five-sixteenths to go, angled five to six wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive lugging in and carrying in GOT TOUGH from the three path to the rail inside the eighth pole and tired. LET EM KNOW made a small lunge at the break, chased four wide under encouragement from the five-sixteenths marker, tipped six wide into upper stretch and tired.

MY NOBLE KNIGHT was taken in hand early, dropped well off the pace, saved ground on the first turn, came through inside of a rival outside the five-eighths pole, moved closer near the nine-sixteenths steady, gained to make a bid in the two path on the far turn, took the lead into upper stretch, responded well in the final furlong and proved best under steady urging. SPOILER saved ground on the first turn, was urged along in third position, moved closer late on the backstretch, chased inside to the three path on the far turn, pursued the winner while outside in the stretch, had the rider drop his right rein while attempting to switch crops late and earned the place. BERNIN HOT went to the front, raced inside on the first turn, showed the way with a clear advantage while in hand, was asked under threat while along the rail on the far turn, lost the advantage to the winner into upper stretch, fought on with that foe into the final furlong and was out-kicked while well clear for the show. REYNOLDS CHANNEL went around the first turn in the four path, raced well off the pace, was urged along in the three then two path on the far turn, moved out in upper stretch and failed to respond. INDY RAGS angled in at the rear of the field, went around the first turn in the two path, settled towards the rear, saved ground on the far turn and was no factor. BRAZENLY was hustled from the gate, rounded the first turn in the three path, dropped back under urging while outside on the backstretch, went around the far turn in the three then two path and also failed to respond. SWEETALKINGBOURBON went around the turns in the four path and showed little then was eased in the final furlong but

walked off. PINEAPPLE MAN established a forward position early, traveled around the opening bend in the two path, tracked the pace on the outside, dropped back leaving the backstretch, retreated in the the three then four path on the far turn, spun into the stretch in the five path and was also eased in the final furlong but walked off.

SOLO JIM chased along the inside briefly and then tipped out two to three paths off the rail near the five furlong marker, came under coaxing with seven-sixteenths to go, angled out seven wide into upper stretch, rallied to take command with three-sixteenths remaining, then edged clear under a drive to prevail. COME FULL CIRCLE broke half a beat slow and was bumped after the start by CONSTANT CHAOS due to pressure from THE TOY CANNON, chased four paths off the inside down the backstretch and then just off the inside through the turn coming under coaxing three furlongs out, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, offered up a bid a furlong out, then couldn't match the winner late while running on to procure the place honors. STAYFROSTYMFRIEND bobbled at the break, chased four to five paths off the inside down the backstretch and then three wide through the turn, went nine to ten wide into upper stretch and improved position kicking on belatedly to secure the show honors. DINNER ROYALE hustled from the gate, dueled inside of THE TOY CANNON from the nine-sixteenths marker, knocked heads through the turn and into upper stretch when spinning three wide, got collared with three-sixteenths to go and kept on to the finish. CORVUS coaxed from the gate, chased six paths off the rail down the backstretch and then four wide through the turn under urging from the seven-sixteenths pole, went nine wide for home and tired. APOLLO CODE coaxed from the start, chased four then two wide under a ride from the five-sixteenths pole, went six wide into upper stretch and tired. THE TOY CANNON broke in at the start under hustling and bumped CONSTANT CHAOS into COME FULL CIRCLE, led briefly before being engaged in head to head combat with DINNER ROYALE with nine-sixteenths remaining while under light coaxing from the get go, angled five wide into upper stretch and was shaken off straightened away, then tired through to the finish. CONSTANT CHAOS got bumped at the start by the aforementioned foe and in turn bumped COME FULL CIRCLE, chased just off the inside and then along the inside under a ride from the seven-sixteenths pole, took the inside route into upper stretch and tired. SEBASTIANTHE FIRST coaxed from the gate, took the overland route seven paths off the inside down the backstretch before heading six wide through the turn, went ten to eleven paths off the inside into upper stretch and tired.

KATHYNMARISSA got brushed after the start and was lightly pinched due to pressure outside initiated by OZARA, raced three paths off the rail past the stands the first time before heading just off the inside through the first turn, settled just off the inside behind the cover of PORTFOLIO DURATION, briefly tipped to the three path before tucking back to the two path, went three wide through the far turn coming under urging near the quarter pole and was floated six wide by DYNAMIC PRICING before straightening away five wide into upper stretch, rallied to issue a challenge inside the final furlong, tussled with her barn mate head to head a sixteenth out, then got up in the final jumps to the finish to score.
