TAB AT ZANZIBAR broke in the start then was hustled, moved up to get the lead then showed the way with a clear advantage, dictated terms in the two path on the turn, was asked outside the quarter-pole, came under one pop of a right-handed crop outside the furlong marker then switched to a left-handed crop, dropped to the rail around the sixteenth-pole and held under strong urging. CALDO CANDY was urged along towards the back, saved ground on the turn, chased inside into the final furlong, moved out outside the sixteenth-pole, gained to make a bid late but missed while clear for the place. OIL CAPITAL was urged along on the inside of a rival, departed the backstretch in hand, chased in the four to five path on the turn, pursued the winner under a drive in the stretch and lacked the needed kick but just earned the show. ROCK MUSIC lost his footing in the hindquarters at the start and was off a step slow, raced near the back under urging, moved from the rail to the four path on the turn, gained into the stretch in the six path, held a reasonable striking position into the final furlong but flattened out and just missed the show. FIVE WISHES hit the outside of the gate at the start, chased the pace on the outside, dropped from the five path to the three path on the turn and weakened. DR. KAPUR chased the early pace, dropped back fast near the nine-sixteenths pole, went around the turn in the three path and failed to threaten. UNBROKEN CHAIN was hustled from the gate, chased the pace down the backstretch, went around the turn in the three then two path and tired.
