EMERGENCY NINE coaxed from the gate, chased just off the inside and then along the inside from just off the top pair, got set down two to three wide at

the quarter pole angling out to swing four to five wide into upper stretch, rallied to collar the leader just outside the eighth pole, then drew clear to the finish to score. WAITIN'ONAPROMISE dueled early on with FOREVER TO GO before tucking to the three path, shook away nearing the half mile pole to sole command then tucked to the two path into the turn, came under coaxing near the quarter pole and spun three wide into upper stretch, dug in under threat and was caught just outside the eighth pole, proved no match for the top one while keeping on to preserve the place honors. FROGHOLLOWSUMMER brushed the near side stall at the start, chased along the inside under coaxing from three furlongs out, spun two to three wide into upper stretch and improved position to get up for the show honors in the final jumps. RAYNHAM HALL bobbed at the break and came under coaxing from the stall, chased four then three wide under urging from the five-sixteenths marker, angled out seven wide into upper stretch and stayed on one paced to the finish. TICKET TO RIDE chased five paths off the hedge down the backstretch before tucking to the two path with seven-sixteenths to go, came under coaxing near the quarter pole and went seven wide into upper stretch, weakened. FOREVER TO GO coaxed from the gate, dueled early on with WAITIN'ONAPROMISE, then chased four then three wide in closest aim of that rival coming under coaxing with five-sixteenths remaining, swung six wide into upper stretch, weakened in the drive. ALL BRIGHT crossed directly to the three path after the start and chased three wide coming under a ride at the three-eighths pole, tipped three to four wide into upper stretch, offered no response. MONTEVERTINE chased three then two wide under urging from three furlongs out, cornered just off the inside into upper stretch and offered no rally. BATTLE RIFLE coaxed from the gate, chased just off the inside under encouragement from the five-sixteenths marker, spun three wide for home, tired. MIZTY FOG coaxed from the start, chased six paths off the hedge down the backstretch and then three wide through the turn ridden along with five-sixteenths to go, swung six wide into upper stretch and tired. IWOKEUPLIKETHIS coaxed from the gate, chased along the inside and was hard held off the heels of FROGHOLLOWSUMMER half a mile from home, then got steadied when MONTEVERTINE came inwards with seven-sixteenths to go, came under coaxing three furlongs out, angled five wide for home and made no impact. DREAMY GIRL a bit fractious in the gate prior to the start, chased five then four wide under a ride from the five-sixteenths marker, tipped six wide into upper stretch and tired.
