CREDIT RISK coaxed from the start, showed the way in hand just off the inside through swift splits, shook off her nearest rival inside the three-eighths marker and steadily shook away, cornered just off the inside into upper stretch and was roused with three-sixteenths to go, drew off under a drive as her competition backed away through the stretch, then got ridden out through the final sixteenth, the outcome in no doubt. NOISETOMAKENOISE chased five to six paths off the inside down the backstretch before tucking three wide into the turn coming under encouragement with seven-sixteenths remaining, swung five wide into upper stretch, proved no match for the top one while keeping on to secure the place honors. THAT'S AMORE chased along the inside coming under a ride with five-sixteenths to go, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, improved position to the eighth pole, then was along well clear of and best of the rest. RUN ON STATES chased five paths off the rail down the backstretch before tucking to the two path through the turn coming under urging three furlongs from home, cornered three wide into upper stretch, tired. BOUNDING ALONG got bumped at the start by KEY ACTRESS, who recovered inwards from a stumble, chased two to three paths off the inside down the backstretch and then along the inside through the turn ridden along from three furlongs out, continued in the inside route into upper stretch and tired. KEY ACTRESS stumbled at the start recovering outwards into BOUNDING ALONG, chased four then three wide in closest aim of the leader coming under coaxing at the three-eighths marker when shaken off by the top one, faded and went four wide into upper stretch, then faltered in the drive. AUTHENTIC BEAUTY chased eight paths off the rail down the backstretch, came under a long drive half a mile from home and tucked four wide through the turn, went six wide into upper stretch and made no impact. MAIZEY BLUE coaxed from the start, chased seven paths off the rail down the backstretch before tucking to the two path into the turn, came under urging with seven-sixteenths to run, went three wide at the head of the stretch, gave way, and was eased through the final furlong to the finish.

GUN BARREL CITY broke out and brushed the gate, angled in at the rear, went around the first turn in the two path, settled outside without cover on the backstretch, tucked in into the far turn, rounded that bend in the three then four path, swung out to the six path into upper stretch, rallied outside into the final furlong, closed well to make a bid outside the sixteenth-pole, fought outside of three opponents to the finish and narrowly prevailed under strong urging. MIDDLE MARKET went around the first turn in the three path, settled off the pace, was roused in the four path on the far turn, rallied to the lead in upper stretch, led gamely into the final sixteenth, fought between horses to the finish and was denied while just able to get the place. MAXIMUM PROMISE saved ground on the first turn, moved off the rail on the backstretch, shifted further out around the seven-sixteenths pole, was roused in the four then five path on the far turn, rallied in upper stretch, closed well to make a bid outside the sixteenth-pole, battled between horses late and just missed while narrowly able to get the show. BLAST FURNACE showed speed between horses, was taken back in hand nearing the first turn, raced in the two path on that bend, was rated off the pace, went around most of the far turn in the two path then shifted to the three path while drafting behind horses, waited while blocked behind traffic into upper stretch, continued to wait until inside the three-sixteenths pole, tipped out a path then was given his cue outside the furlong marker, found

clear space in front outside the sixteenth-pole and closed well to just miss in a blanket finish. MADAGASCAR saved ground on the first turn, came off the rail under reserve near the five-eighths pole, was hard held late on the backstretch, went around the far turn in the three path while under restraint, waited behind traffic into upper stretch, tipped to the four path and was asked near the three-sixteenths pole, steadied behind horses while remaining on his inside lead near the eighth-pole, continued on his inside lead while dropping inward in the final furlong and gained willingly but missed the superfecta. IN THE DARK established a forward position early, tugged a bit keen on the bit in the four path on the first turn, stalked outside without cover, made a bid near the seven-sixteenths pole, vied in the three path while asked on the far turn, battled under a drive into the final furlong and weakened. TOUGH CRITIC went around the first turn in the two path, settled off the pace, was roused while inside on the far turn, turned into upper stretch under a drive and failed to rally. LIGHT FANTASTIC showed speed on the inside of foes, raced in the two path on the first turn, showed the way down the backstretch, was asked while inside on the far turn, lost the advantage in upper stretch and gave way. SHANGRALA ROAD was hustled from the gate then showed speed between horses, traveled around the first turn in the three path, prompted the pace on the outside of the leader, passed the five-eighths pole on even terms for the lead, was asked in the two path on the far turn, battled under a drive into the final furlong and tired.

GARDEN OF GRACE broke in a step filling the space left vacant by YOU KNOW BETTER, chased just off the inside and then along the inside from near

the rear of the field coming under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, spun three wide into upper stretch, tipped out a path near the eighth pole and rallied to issue a challenge inside that station, collared the leader seventy yards from the finish and inched away in the late stages to prevail. AVERY'S WONDERLAND chased three then two wide patiently handled until set down spinning just off the inside into upper stretch and seized command straightened away, dug in under a drive inching away briefly before coming under growing threat to the outside and was caught seventy yards from the finish while clear for the place honors. MIDTOWN MISCHIEF coaxed from the gate, vied from the three path between foes among a quarter and then a trio and was carried out four then five wide from the three-eighths pole to the five-sixteenths pole when BLUE AUTHENTICITY got out along her inside, and in turn carried out MISCHIEVOUS JO five then six wide, angled back in to seize narrow and brief command swinging three to four wide into upper stretch, got headed straightened away by the aforementioned foe, then kept on to preserve the show honors on the wire. STELLA FORTUNA chased three wide under urging from the five-sixteenths marker, angled out seven then six wide into upper stretch and improved position to the finish. YOU KNOW BETTER tossed her head and was off a beat slow and then lost her lane at the start to GARDEN OF GRACE, chased two to three paths off the inside down the backstretch and then three to four wide through the turn, angled nine wide into upper stretch and passed tired rivals to the finish. BANK ON BEBE chased along the inside coming under coaxing near the quarter pole, took the inside route into upper stretch, offered up a bid a furlong out, then flattened out in the late stages. DANCING MIRACLE broke out a step at the start and was corrected before making contact with YOU KNOW BETTER, chased just off the inside under a ride with five-sixteenths to go, angled six wide into upper stretch and offered no kick. SPIRIT FORWARD got bumped at the start by ANNA BROCKNANA, due to pressure from MISCHIEVOUS JO, chased three to four paths off the inside down the backstretch and then just off the inside through the turn, went nine to ten wide at the head of the stretch and offered no response. MISCHIEVOUS JO came out at the start bumping ANNA BROCKNANA into SPIRIT FORWARD, vied between foes from the four path down the backstretch, continued four wide into the turn, then got carried out five then six wide from the three-eighths marker to the five-sixteenths marker by MIDTOWN MISCHIEF due to pressure from the getting out BLUE AUTHENTICITY to their inside, tucked briefly four wide near the quarter pole before heading back six wide into upper stretch and tired. ANNA BROCKNANA got bumped at the start by the aforementioned foe and in turn bumped SPIRIT FORWARD, vied from the five path outside a trio down the backstretch, was going to be hung out five wide and eased off three furlongs out and was able to tuck three wide escaping being carried out by BLUE AUTHENTICITY getting out midway on the turn, came under urging with five-sixteenths to go and swung four wide into upper stretch, then tired through to the finish. BLUE AUTHENTICITY bobbed after the break, vied from the two path inside a trio and then a pair of rivals, came under a firm left grip three furlongs out and got out three then four wide carrying out MIDTOWN MISCHIEF and MISCHIEVOUS JO, angled back in to the two path nearing the quarter pole and yielded command just outside that station, cornered three wide for home and was placed to a protective hold straightened away into upper stretch, then got eased home to the finish before walking off under her own power.
