BABCIE dueled three then two wide with ALL FUN N GAMES to her inside, got roused spinning three to four paths off the inside into upper stretch, shook off her main pace rival straightened away and drew off under a light drive, then got geared down inside the final sixteenth with the outcome in no doubt. HANNA'S HIDEAWAY coaxed from the gate, led briefly early on before settling to chase four paths off the inside down the backstretch and then four wide through the turn under coaxing from the three-eighths marker, tipped six wide into upper stretch, proved no match for the top one while keeping on to secure the place honors. MS NIKKI D chased along the inside and then just off the inside under a ride from three furlongs out, went seven wide into upper stretch and stayed on one paced to the finish. CAMILLE'S LEGACY broke out a step at the start bumping BIG JACKIE lightly, chased just off the inside under encouragement from three furlongs out, tipped three to four wide for home and improved position through to the finish. ALL FUN N GAMES coaxed from the gate, dueled inside of BABCIE from the six furlong marker lightly coaxed along, came under urging with five-sixteenths to go, cut the corner into upper stretch and was shaken off straightened away and tired through to the finish. BIG JACKIE got bumped at the start by CAMILLE'S LEGACY, chased three wide under urging from the seven-sixteenths pole, spun just off the inside into upper stretch and tired. TWO BY TWO BY TWO chased five then four wide under urging from the seven-sixteenths pole, went seven to eight wide into upper stretch, made no impact.

CONFLICT dropped back early, moved from the rail to the two path early on the first turn, settled last but one, was urged along late on the backstretch, advanced while shifting from the two path to the three path on the far turn, rallied in the five path into the stretch, closed fast to make a bid inside the three-sixteenths pole, took the lead near the furlong marker, battled outside of two foes into the final sixteenth and proved best under good handling. JUST PEACHY was taken in hand off heels early then bumped with CELEBRATE, moved in towards the rear, rounded the first turn in the two path, settled comfortably on the backstretch, saved ground on the far turn, was roused in the two path after turning into the stretch, rallied to make a bid between horses at the furlong marker, battled inside of two rivals into the final sixteenth and was outfinished but narrowly earned the place. MANDY STEPH was well placed just off the pace on the inside, came off the rail while asked on the far turn, rallied in the four path into the stretch, closed well to make a bid inside the three-sixteenths pole, fought between horses into the final sixteenth, drifted in some near that point and was also outfinished then just missed the place but was clear for the show. CELEBRATE bumped with JUST PEACHY early, angled in at the rear, dropped from the two path to the inside early on the first turn, was unhurried at the back, saved ground for most of the far turn then shifted to the three path, gained into the stretch in the six path, remained on her inside lead in the drive and flattened out while improving position for the last spot in the superfecta. MARGIE'S GIRL came away in good order, tossed her head while rank early, raced in the three path on the first turn, prompted the pace on the outside, turned up the pressure in the two path on the final turn, spun into the stretch in the three path while roused for more, battled under a drive into the final furlong, dropped back outside the sixteenth-pole and weakened. HARMONY MILL rounded the first turn in the two path, settled just off the pace, was urged along passing the nine-sixteenths pole, dropped back in the two path on the far turn, was driven into the stretch in the four path and failed to rally. MISS MA'AM went to the front, showed the way on the inside while inside of an opponent, was asked under threat on the far turn, battled under a drive into the final furlong and gave way. LOOP D LOOP raced in the three path on the first turn, settled on the outside, chased in the three path on the far turn and came up empty.

MY GUN'S LOADED coaxed from the gate, raced two to three wide through the first turn and then three paths off the inside down the backstretch, went three then four wide through the far turn advancing on the front before bidding five to six wide from the five-sixteenths marker to the quarter pole circling rivals to take command straightened away for home, then edged clear under a drive and was lightly ridden out in the late stages. KRISSYS STAR brushed the near side stall at the start and then got bumped by BERNIEANDTHEROSE, raced under a firm hold early on while tracking inside before settling better midway down the backstretch, continued along the inside through the far turn coming under coaxing with five-sixteenths to go, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, ran on to secure the place honors. BOW DRAW coaxed from the gate, chased three then four paths off the inside coming under coaxing near the quarter pole, seized narrow command at that station swinging five then four wide into upper stretch, got displaced straightened away and weakened in the late stages. LIKA ROLLING STONE coaxed from the start, chased two then three wide in closest aim of the leader, came under coaxing with seven-sixteenths remaining and advanced to take over the front with five-sixteenths to go already under threat to the outside, yielded command swinging three wide into upper stretch and then weakened in the stretch. SOUNDBITE broke out at the start and was corrected, raced four then three wide in that first turn before tucking to the two path midway, chased just off the inside coming under coaxing near the quarter pole, got let out angled four wide into upper stretch, then tired in the drive. BERNIEANDTHEROSE broke out a step at the start bumping KRISSYS STAR, showed the way in hand along the inside down the backstretch and then just off the inside through the far turn coming under urging three furlongs from home, yielded command with five-sixteenths to go, swung three wide into upper stretch in retreat, got eased home through to the finish, then was reported to have bled.

SALMING coaxed from the gate, chased just off the inside down the backstretch and then three to four wide through the turn coming under coaxing near the quarter pole, swung five then four wide into upper stretch and seized command straightened away, then drew clear under a drive to prevail. MITOLEON DYNAMITE dropped back quickly then retreated towards the rear of the field, saved ground on the turn, came out into the stretch and was eased but walked off.

CHUMMERS raced just off the inside through the first turn and then three paths off the rail down the backstretch, went three to four wide through the far turn coming under encouragement near the quarter pole and angled seven wide into upper stretch, rallied to take command just inside the three-sixteenths marker, dug in under threat and came out under a left handed crop bumping CAROLINE ST. BEAT near the sixteenth pole, then got brushed by that rival coming in under a right handed crop twice to the finish and held gamely by a neck to score. CAROLINE ST. BEAT along the inside through the first turn, settled two to three wide at the tail of the field, came under coaxing near the quarter pole and went eight wide at the top of the stretch, rallied to issue a challenge through the final furlong latching on the leader to the outside, got bumped by the top one coming out under a left handed crop just outside the sixteenth pole, then came in under his own crop right handed and brushed with CHUMMERS twice through to the finish fighting on well but was ultimately repelled to the wire. A LITTLE AT FIRST raced four wide into the first turn and came inwards bumping MANOR PARK into NEWLYN before NEWLYN bumped that foe back outwards into him, raced three to four wide through the first turn before chasing three wide from just off the pace, came under coaxing near the quarter pole and swung five wide at the head of the lane rallying to take narrow and brief command three-sixteenths from home, got headed inside that station and then kept on to the wire well clear for the show honors. NEWLYN got bumped by MANOR PARK due to pressure from A LITTLE AT FIRST with seven and a half furlongs remaining into the first turn, tracked the front just off the inside from near the rear of the field, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths pole, swung four wide for home and improved position to the finish. SPIRIT OF NEW YORK broke out a step at the start, knocked heads with VOODOO DOLL early on before easing off that rival in track three then two wide in closest aim, advanced and seized command just inside the five-sixteenths pole, swung three then two wide into upper stretch under threat and yielded with three-sixteenths remaining, then weakened through to the finish. MANOR PARK got bumped two to three wide between foes into the first turn when A LITTLE AT FIRST came inwards and in turn bumped NEWLYN, then had NEWLYN come outwards and was bumped back into A LITTLE AT FIRST, tracked the pace along the inside coming under urging near the quarter

pole, spun two to three wide into upper stretch and tired. VODOO DOLL bobbed at the break, recovered to knock heads briefly with SPIRIT OF NEW YORK before establishing sole command under a rating hold just off the inside through the first turn and down the backstretch, tucked inside into the far turn and came under increased pressure to the outside, yielded the front just inside the five-sixteenths marker, took the inside route into upper stretch and folded.

LIMITED EDITION settled while saving ground, was roused while moving from the two path to the four path on the final turn, rallied outside into upper stretch, closed fast to get the lead inside the three-sixteenths pole, went clear under a drive near the furlong marker, swapped back to her inside lead inside that marker, went back to the proper lead late and proved much the best under steady urging. DONNADOYAWANNA went to the front, showed the way on the inside, lost the lead approaching the second turn, moved to the two path after being eased back off the pace on that bend, tracked outside on the backstretch, gained to make a bid in the two path on the final turn, took the lead late on that bend, lost the advantage to the winner in upper stretch and proved no match while clear for the place. GOLD SOVEREIGN went around the first turn in the two path, settled while saving ground near the middle of the field, was urged along in the three then four path on the final turn, turned into upper stretch under a drive and lacked the needed response while able to get the show. ORGONITE bumped with a rival at the start, tugged on the bit into the first turn, was reserved while two path to the inside, was roused on the final turn, moved to the three path late on that bend, turned into upper stretch under a drive and weakened. LAHAINALUNA saved ground while settled towards the rear, moved out on the backstretch, was urged along in the three path on the final turn, angled out in upper stretch and failed to threaten. MORTAL LOCK settled at the rear while saving ground, was roused on the final turn, came out into upper stretch, dropped in inside the furlong marker and lacked the needed response. INSTANTLY settled with cover while inside to the two path, was roused on the final turn, swung out to the five path into the stretch and was no factor. WAR AND MAJESTY tugged on the bit in the three path on the first turn, prompted the pace on the outside without cover, turned up the pressure on the leader with about seven furlongs to run then took a short lead, moved clear in the two path on the second turn, was asked while shortening stride along the rail on the final turn, lost the advantage inside the five-sixteenths pole and tired. DAUNTING (FR) bumped with a foe at the start, settled near the back in the two path with cover, was removed from cover on the backstretch, traveled around the final turn in the two path under urging and failed

to respond.
