INTRAOSSIOUS was urged along off the pace, went around the turn in the two path, turned into the stretch in the three path under the crop, rallied to get the lead inside the furlong marker and drew clear under steady urging. MYSTICIOUS moved up after the start, stalked the pace on the outside, was asked in the three path on the turn, spun into upper stretch in the five path, chased into the final furlong, kept on in pursuit of the winner to the finish and willingly earned the place. LUCERRA was well placed just off the pace, chased inside on the turn, cut the corner into the stretch, pursued the leader along the rail into the final furlong and weakened but was clear for the show. ELEVATED went to the front then showed the way, rounded the turn in the two path, was asked near the quarter-pole, came under a right-handed crop in upper stretch, lost the advantage inside the furlong marker and tired. BADITTUDE was urged along on the outside, went around the turn in the four path, drifted in inside the furlong marker and lacked the needed response. HELP A GIRL OUT was urged along towards the rear then moved out, went around the turn in the three to four path, was driven into upper stretch in the six path then moved further out and failed to threaten. LADY GIRVIN lacked early speed, climbed greenly into kickback at the rear, raced inside for most of the turn then shifted to the three path, came out to the seven path into upper stretch and was no factor. TEXAS DANDELION dropped back towards the rear of the field, traveled around the turn in the two path and failed to respond. MS LIU dropped back while urged along, raced inside to the two path on the turn and retreated.

POWER OF WOMEN buckled at the break and came under coaxing directly to the front despite it, showed the way in hand just off the inside patiently handled, shook away through the latter portion of the turn given a notch, spun three wide into upper stretch and was roused with three-sixteenths to go, drew clear under a drive to inside the sixteenth marker and then got geared down in the late stages. LADY WISDOM chased along the inside until tipped to the three path lightly nudging SUCCESSFUL AGENDA four wide at the half mile pole, came under urging with seven-sixteenths to go and chased three wide through the turn and then six wide into upper stretch, ran on to chase the winner home well clear of the rest and along second best. A. P. SLINGSHOT three then two wide through the first turn, chased three to four paths off the inside down the backstretch until tucked inside through the far turn, came under encouragement at the seven-sixteenths pole, spun just off the inside into upper stretch and tired. SUCCESSFUL AGENDA forwardly placed three wide early on, got nudged briefly to the four path at the half mile pole by LADY WISDOM, came under urging with three and a half furlongs to run, tipped four wide into upper stretch and faltered in the drive.

GRAND YAUPON broke in and bumped soundly with GOLD ON BLACK, disputed the pace on the outside of two rivals, vied in the four path on the turn, was roused at the quarter-pole, took the lead inside the three-sixteenths pole, was guided out closer to the runner-up when that foe made a challenge inside the furlong marker, dueled gamely with that opponent to the finish and narrowly prevailed under strong urging. BELZONI moved in while establishing a good position just off the pace, drafted in the three then four path on the turn, was roused in the five path into the stretch, gained to make a bid inside the furlong marker, dueled outside of the winner to the finish and was denied while well clear for the place. FOOLIN moved in early then was well spotted just off the pace, saved ground on the turn, came through a rail opening to make a bid outside the quarter-pole then took the lead, lost the advantage to the winner while under a drive in upper stretch and proved no match for the top two while well clear for the show. GOLD ON BLACK bumped soundly with GRAND YAUPON at the start, was urged along on the outside, went around the turn in the four to five path, spun into the stretch in the six path, drifted in while remaining on his inside lead into the final furlong and lacked the needed response. BACKLASH angled in early then was urged along at the rear, went around the turn in the two then three path, swung out to the seven path into the stretch and failed to threaten. WARRIOR AT HEART was urged along towards the rear, saved ground on the turn, cut the corner into the stretch and was no factor. CACTUS CLOSER showed speed then disputed the pace between horses, vied in the three path while still between opponents on the turn, dropped back into the stretch and faded. BLACKJACK lost his footing some just after the start, moved up while sent hard, contested the pace on the inside of two foes, vied in the two path while still inside those rivals on the turn, dropped between horses into upper stretch then moved out and faltered then was eased but walked off.

COUNTING STARS established the front from the get go and showed the way in hand just off the inside through the first turn and then three paths off the rail down the backstretch settled into a comfortable rhythm, remained on hold showing the way tucked back to the two path through the far turn and had ALWAYS A RUNNER advance along the open rail nearing the quarter pole, spun three wide into upper stretch placed to light urging, got bumped by ALWAYS A RUNNER coming out inside the three-sixteenths marker and was roused at that juncture, shook off her main rival inside the eighth pole and edged clear under a drive to the finish to score. LEAVE ME brushed the near side stall at the start and then lightly bumped DRAYDEN before ricocheting off that rival and bumping ZIP FOR RICK, raced just off the inside through the first turn and then three wide thereafter coming under coaxing near the quarter pole, angled five wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive rallying to issue a challenge inside the final furlong and was up in the last jumps to prevail. GILBANE tracked the pace along the inside coming under coaxing near the quarter pole, spun three wide into upper stretch, came in straightened away seizing command when bumping FOTO into FOLLOWILL, edged clear briefly before coming under threat to the outside, dug in head to head to the finish and was caught in the final jumps to the finish. KULEANA three then two wide through the first turn, chased two to three wide under a ride from the five-sixteenths marker, swung four wide for home and kept on to the wire. FOLLOWILL coaxed from the gate, showed the way in hand along the inside coming under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, yielded the front near the quarter pole and took the inside route into upper stretch, got bumped by FOTO due to pressure from GILBANE and weakened in the late

stages. BIG FAT GOALIE dwelt at the start getting away last and conceding seven to eight lengths to the front, chased three then two wide under a ride from the five-sixteenths pole, swung four wide into upper stretch and improved position to the end. LOBBYIST raced just off the inside through the first turn and then three to four paths off the inside down the backstretch, tucked to the to path through the far turn and continued just off the inside into upper stretch and weakened. ZIP FOR RICK got bumped after the start by LEAVE ME, raced four then three wide through the first turn and then four wide down the backstretch and through the far turn coaxed along from the five-sixteenths, swung five to six wide into upper stretch and tired. DRAYDEN got bumped at the start by LEAVE ME, chased just off the inside and then along the inside coming under encouragement near the quarter pole, spun two to three wide into upper stretch and tired. FOTO raced just off the inside through the first turn, settled two to three wide in closest aim of the leader, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths pole, took over command and spun just off the inside into upper stretch, got bumped when headed for command near the three-sixteenths pole and in turn bumped FOLLOWILL along the rail, then tired through to the finish. There was a Stewards Inquiry into upper stretch focusing on the bumping between GILBANE, FOTO and FOLLOWILL. After review, the result was allowed to stand.
