HIGH OFFICIAL settled tracking from just off the inside just off the pace, came under coaxing near the quarter pole and swung five wide into upper stretch, rallied to take command a sixteenth out, edged away to the finish kept to task. HARBAUGH tracked the leader from the two path in closest aim, advanced on that rival into the far turn coming under coaxing with five-sixteenths to go, swung four wide for home rallying to seize command with three-sixteenths remaining, dug in under threat to the outside and was caught a sixteenth from home, ran on well clear of the rest for the place honors. JERSEY GUY along the inside through the first turn, chased two to three paths off the rail down the backstretch and then just off the inside through the far turn coming under urging with five-sixteenths to run, swung four wide into upper stretch, kept on to the finish. KIPROS shied in at the start from GENEVA LAKE breaking inwards, then altered out as that rival continued in, saved ground near the rear of the field coming under encouragement with five-sixteenths to go, spun three wide into upper stretch and improved position to the wire. SHOWA chased along the inside under a ride nearing the quarter pole, cornered three wide into upper stretch, weakened in the drive. BLUE LAW chased just off the inside under a ride with five-sixteenths to run, angled four wide into upper stretch, made no impact. GENEVA LAKE broke inwards and directly to the front forcing KIPROS to shy in before carrying him in very briefly, pulled on the bit keen and green showing some headstrong strides and shaking away early on from the two path through the first turn, continued eager into the backstretch and tucked to the inside near the nine-sixteenths marker, had the field take closer order at that juncture and continued along the inside through the far turn under pressure from HARBAUGH to the outside with five-sixteenths to go, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, yielded the front at the three-sixteenths pole and weakened through to the finish. LE PATRON got steadied after the start when HIGH OFFICIAL took over his lane, chased two to three wide under urging from the five-sixteenths marker, swung four wide into upper stretch and made no impact.

VACATION DANCE settled comfortably off the pace, saved ground on the turn, was asked for his best in upper stretch, rallied inside into the final furlong, moved out under a left-handed crop while gaining coming to the sixteenth-pole, espied a small seam between horses at that juncture, bumped with BILLIONAIRES ROW into the final sixteenth and got up to prevail. FLUID SITUATION went to the front then opened up a clear advantage, traveled around the turn in the two path, was asked after turning into the stretch, came under a right-handed crop inside the furlong marker, led into the final sixteenth but was caught while just able to get the place. SON OF A BIRCH broke a step slow, was urged along towards the rear, raced inside to the two path on the turn, angled out under a drive in upper stretch, rallied outside in the final furlong and closed fast to just miss the place while clear for the show. BILLIONAIRES ROW broke a half-step slow, moved up under coaxing to race in the second flight, chased inside on the turn, came off the rail into the stretch, moved out a bit more while in pursuit of the leader in upper stretch, gained on the pacesetter coming to the sixteenth-pole, had the lean in trying to prevent the winner from finding a seam at that juncture and bumped with that opponent then was out-kicked. DOCTOR JEFF was urged along in the second flight on the outside, dropped back in the two path on the turn, came into the stretch in the four path and lacked the needed kick. NIAGARA SKYLINE was hustled from the gate then urged along on the outside, went around the turn in the three path, turned into upper stretch under a drive and lacked the needed response. TRUST ISSUES was off slow and spotted the front a few lengths, settled at the rear, traveled around the turn in the two path and was no factor. FOLLOWING A STEWARDS' INQUIRY INTO THE STRETCH RUN, NO CHANGE WAS MADE TO THE ORDER OF FINISH

BEIRA bobbled at the break, chased just off the inside until tipped three wide placed to urging with five-sixteenths remaining, angled six wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive rallying inside the final furlong and was just up on the wire to prevail. RACING COLORS bobbled at the break and was bumped by ANGEL BELLA breaking inwards, chased along the inside coming under encouragement at the five-sixteenths marker, advanced along the rail and cut the corner into upper stretch seizing command just inside the eighth pole, edged clear under a drive to inside the eighth pole, dug in under growing late threat to the outside getting leg weary late and was nailed on the line. ANGEL BELLA broke in at the start bumping RACING COLORS, raced three wide through the first turn and prompted the leader from the outside three wide down the backstretch, advanced on that rival to duel through the far turn taking narrow and brief command just inside the five-sixteenths pole, got displaced just inside the quarter pole and swung four to five wide into upper stretch, then kept on to secure the show honors. ROYAL BOBBIE broke out at the start, raced five then four wide through the first turn, chased four wide under coaxing from the three-eighths pole, went seven wide into upper stretch and had no kick. BOURBON N LACE four then three wide through the first turn, chased three wide under a ride from the seven-sixteenths pole, angled five wide for home and offered no response. KATIE KING coaxed from the gate, showed the way in hand just off the inside under some pressure through the presence of ANGEL BELLA to the outside, had that rival advance and dueled with that foe through the far turn ridden along with seven-sixteenths to go, spun three wide into upper stretch, yielded the front straightened away and tired. DON'T BE SALT Y broke out a step at the start and was taken hold of briefly to bot make contact with RACING COLORS, chased just off the inside into the first turn and grew detached at the tail of the field, steadily lost ground down the backstretch and through the far turn, was guided three wide into upper stretch and trailed while never getting involved.

SENIOR OFFICER brushed the off side stall at the start, tucked to chase just off the inside coming in slightly and forcing TARANTINO to check along the rail just inside five and a half furlongs to run, remained just off the inside until tucked inside through the turn coming under coaxing near the quarter pole, spun just off the inside into upper stretch and paused in behind the lugging in ACOUSTIC AVE, angled in to the rail once STARS AND STRIPES vacated that position backing away near the eighth pole, then tipped back to the two path in front of a weakening ACOUSTIC AVE to make his last surge at TIP TOP THOMAS and was just up in the final jumps to prevail. TIP TOP THOMAS broke out at the start bumping ACOUSTIC AVE, pressed the pace of STARS AND STRIPES from the outside four paths off the rail down the backstretch and then just off the inside through the turn, came under coaxing near the quarter pole seizing command and took the inside route into upper stretch, edged clear under a drive to inside the eighth pole, dug in under late threat and was nailed in the final strides. SACROSANCT chased four paths off the inside down the backstretch and then just off the inside through the turn coming under coaxing three furlongs from home, angled five wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild kick to prevail in a head to head battle for the show honors. BRING THE SMOKE got away to a stumbling beginning pawing the group for the first two strides, chased two to three paths off the inside down the backstretch before tucking inside through the turn, came under light urging with seven-sixteenths to run, angled four wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild kick dueling through the final furlong with SACROSANCT to his outside and was just bested for the show honors on the line. ACOUSTIC AVE got bumped at the start by TIP TOP THOMAS, chased four to five paths off the inside down the backstretch, tucked three then two wide through the turn coming under coaxing near the quarter pole, spun two to three wide into upper stretch and lugged in near the three-sixteenths forcing SENIOR OFFICER to pause in behind, dug in prominent to the eighth pole, then weakened in the late stages. TARANTINO chased along the inside, got checked just inside five and a

half furlongs to run when very briefly placed in tight by SENIOR OFFICER, continued along the inside until tipped two then three wide through the turn coming under urging midway, angled seven wide into upper stretch and made no impact. STARS AND STRIDES established the front shortly after the start and showed the way in hand along the inside under pressure from TIP TOP THOMAS to the outside, got coaxed along midway on the turn, yielded the front nearing the quarter pole and took the inside route into upper stretch, then tired through to the finish.

WHITETHORN broke out and bumped the hindquarters of an opponent while last to commence, brushed with ISADORA DUNCAN into the first turn, was reserved near the back in the two to three path, advanced closer while full of run on the final turn, bumped with AMERICAN DEBUTANTE in the five path into the stretch, rallied to get the lead outside the furlong marker then powered away under a hand-ride to prove much the best. MARY LOIS (IRE) was reserved in the three then two path near the middle of the field, gained in the three then four path on the final turn, bumped with DON'T LOOK NOW outside the three-sixteenths pole then made a bid, battled under a drive into the final furlong and proved no match for the winner while able to get the place. EENYMEANYMIGHTYMO was taken back along the rail early, clipped the heels of AMERICAN DEBUTANTE nearing the first turn and stumbled, saved ground under a tight hold, moved out to the three path while getting closer on the final turn, dropped in under a right-handed crop inside the three-sixteenths

pole, gained to make a bid coming to the furlong marker then brushed with RAGING BLOOM and narrowly earned the show while unable to go with the top two. DON'T LOOK NOW dropped from the two path to the inside on the first turn, was reserved while saving ground, moved out on the final turn, bumped with MARY LOIS outside the three-sixteenths pole, raced behind a wall of horses shortly thereafter, found room into the final furlong and lacked the needed kick. ONEHOTMESS stumbled at the start then bumped with a foe, was caught out in the four path early on the first turn then dropped to the path, raced at the rear, saved ground on the second turn, continued at the back, advanced while going from the two path to the four path on the final turn, swung out to the seven path into the stretch, chased under a drive into the final furlong and weakened. AMERICAN DEBUTANTE (IRE) was clipped in the hindquarters by EANYMEANYMIGHTYMO nearing the first turn, saved ground while keen early then was reserved off the pace, moved from the two path to the four path while gaining on the far turn, bumped with the winner while in the six path into the stretch and lacked the needed response. ISADORA DUNCAN (IRE) brushed with WHITETHORN into the first turn then was taken up, raced in the two to three path under reserve, dropped to the inside on the final turn, moved back to the two path outside the quarter-pole, spun into upper stretch in the three path, moved out in the final furlong and failed to menace. RAGING BLOOM established a forward position, raced inside for most of the first turn, was taken back late on that bend then tossed her head while rank and shifted to the two path, stalked the pace on the outside, vied on even terms for the lead while between horses on the final turn, battled under a drive in upper stretch, brushed with an opponent near the furlong marker and tired. ABUNDANT LOVE dropped from the three path to the two path on the opening bend, was reserved off the pace, moved out from behind cover near the nine-sixteenths pole then advanced closer to the leader, took a short lead in the three path on the far turn, battled under a drive into the final furlong and also tired. PHANTOM BLUE was placed towards the front early, dropped from the two path to the inside while going clear late on the first turn, showed the way while saving ground, came under urging late on the backstretch, lost the lead early on the final turn and stopped. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate times.
