WOOD ISLAND came away in good order then quickly darted clear, showed the way while two path to the inside, responded well when asked coming to the three-sixteenths pole, accelerated further clear into the final furlong, maintained a three length margin into the final sixteenth and held under a strong hand-ride to the finish. JACKPOT JACKIE broke out and bumped with MAMBO JAZZ, angled in under urging at the rear then settled into stride, drafted inside on the turn, was asked once straightened into the stretch, came off the rail shortly thereafter, pursued the winner under a drive into the final sixteenth, gained willingly on that opponent late and was well clear for the place. MAMBO JAZZ was bumped at the start, raced inside of a foe while urged along under extra right-rein pressure, chased in the three to two path on the turn, dropped back while remaining on his inside lead in upper stretch and tired. ZODIAC WARRIOR was urged along on the outside, chased in the four to three path on the turn, dropped back in upper stretch and capitulated.

YOU ARE MY SUZIE Q coaxed from the gate, dueled inside of MISS MONEY PANTS coming under coaxing at the five-sixteenths pole, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, edged clear under a drive to prevail. RISKY MISSION coaxed from the start, raced four then three wide just off the duel coming under encouragement with five-sixteenths to go, swung four wide into upper stretch, ran on willingly for the place honors. BELTANDSUSPENDERS broke last without incident and conceded three lengths to the front before settling into stride, chased just off the inside down the backstretch and then along the inside through the turn, cut the corner into upper stretch, tipped out with three-sixteenths to go and kicked on belatedly to the wire. MISS MONEY PANTS hustled from the gate, dueled from the two path with YOU ARE MY SUZIE Q to her inside, came under urging with five-sixteenths remaining, spun three wide for home and weakened in the late stages. CREAM PUFF tossed her head and lost her lane at the start when breaking a beat slow and having MISS MONEY PANTS fill in the gap, chased along the inside and then just off the inside under a ride from the five-sixteenths marker, continued just off the inside into upper stretch and weakened. SOLO BELLE got coaxed along in pursuit from the get go three then two wide, angled four to five wide into upper stretch, made no impact. X TEN DOE stumbled at the start but recovered to break among the top quartet, chased three wide under a ride with five-sixteenths remaining, tipped four wide into upper stretch and faltered in the drive.

MURSAL was well placed just off the pace, saved ground on the turn, was roused late on that bend, spun into the stretch in the two path, pursued the runner-up under a drive into the final furlong then made a bid, passed the sixteenth-pole on even terms for the lead and got up under strong urging to narrowly prevail. SWEET NOTE showed speed from the outside post and set the pace, moved in around the nine-sixteenths pole, went around the turn in the two path, was asked while inside into the stretch, came under a left-handed crop outside the furlong marker, switched to a right-handed crop under heavy threat from the runner-up outside the sixteenth-pole and was caught while clear for the place. EDISTRUDIS settled off the pace, was urged along late on the backstretch, shifted from the rail to the three path on the turn, swung into the stretch in the five path then moved further out and just got up for the show. PROUD FOOT bumped with rivals on both sides at the start, bumped with two foes early, settled towards the front, chased in the three path on the turn, turned into upper stretch under a drive, dropped back into the final furlong and tired. CONFIRMED STAR bumped with PROUD FOOT at the start, bumped again with that foe early, was urged along near the back, went around the turn in the two to three path, came into the stretch in the four path, drifted out near the three-sixteenths pole and just missed the show. SHEER WILL broke in and bumped with PROUD FOOT, bumped again with that opponent early, moved to the outside then settled at the rear, dropped well behind while moving from the six path to the eight path on the turn and was pulled up in upper stretch then transported off the track via equine ambulance. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.

UNION DOOS coaxed from the gate, chased four wide under urging from the five-sixteenths pole, angled five wide into upper stretch, weakened. AMELIA'S ECHO broke out at the start, chased seven paths off the inside down the backstretch and then four wide through the turn under coaxing from the three-eighths marker, went eight wide at the head of the stretch and passed tired rivals. EXPECTO PATRONUM broke out at the start, chased five paths off the rail down the backstretch and then three wide through the turn under a ride with seven-sixteenths to go, swung six wide into upper stretch and weakened. ROCKYTA coaxed from the gate, chased just off the inside and then along the inside under urging from the seven-sixteenths pole, took the inside route into upper stretch and tired. LESLIE'S STAR broke out at the start, chased six paths off the inside down the backstretch and then three wide through the turn ridden along from the the three-eighths marker, continued three wide at the head of the lane, trailed.
