URGENCY came outward after the start, dropped from the four path to the two path on the first turn, was rated off the pace, stalked in the two path on the far turn, came out while roused into the stretch then drifted a bit further out, rallied outside to get the lead outside the furlong marker and drew away under strong urging to prove much the best. DISPARATE IMPACT brushed with an opponent at the start, dropped from the seven path to the three path on the first turn, prompted the pace on the outside, took the lead outside the half-mile pole, vied two path to the inside on the far turn, was asked outside the quarter-pole then came under a drive into upper stretch, lost the advantage to the winner outside the furlong marker and proved no match while clear for the place. MEANSTEPPER brushed with a rival at the start then was hustled, brushed with another foe early then was squeezed back in tight quarters, went around the first turn in the six then five path, was reserved on the outside, rounded the far turn in the three then four path while roused, was carried out some in upper stretch and lacked the needed response while up for the show. AUTHENTIC LEGEND was hustled from the gate, bumped with a rival while carried out early, went around the first turn in the five then four path, settled on the outside, moved closer with five furlongs to run, made a bid late on the backstretch, vied in the three then two path while given his cue on the far turn, turned into upper stretch under a drive, dropped back into the final furlong and weakened. DIXIE HEX was hustled from the gate, bumped with a rival early while brushing with another foe then checked while squeezed back, dropped from the six path to the three path while placed under tight restraint on the first turn, steadied some while rank behind horses turning onto the backstretch, raced under reserve, was urged along while going from the two path to the four path on the far turn and failed to threaten. CEDERBERG

stumbled badly at the start, saved ground on the first turn, was well placed just off the pace on the backstretch, dropped back into the far turn, moved from the rail to the two path under urging on that bend and failed to respond. STREETCAR moved out while going to the front, dropped from the three path to the two path on the first turn, showed the way on the inside of an opponent, lost the lead outside the half-mile pole, came up empty along the rail on the far turn and stopped then was eased in the stretch but walked off.
