VOYAGER established the front shortly after the break and showed the way in hand just off the inside patiently handled, continued in the two path into upper stretch, got set down with three-sixteenths to go, edged clear under a drive to inside the eighth pole, dug in under growing late threat to the outside and held on gamely on the wire. CORRELATION TRADE (GB) broke a half a beat slow and was steadied very briefly off the heels of BITTERSWEET MEMORY who took over her lane, raced two to three wide in pursuit coming under coaxing near the quarter pole, angled five then four wide into upper stretch, offered up a good finish to close with a rush and just missed on the line. BITTERSWEET MEMORY broke in at the start filling the space left vacant by the aforementioned foe breaking half a beat slow, chased three wide coming under encouragement at the five-sixteenths marker, continued three wide for home and weakened in the late stages. BASHFULLY bobbled after the start, chased along the inside from the tail of the field coming under a ride from the five-sixteenths pole, angled four wide into upper stretch, improved position passing tired rivals. PAVLOVA'S PALACE (GB) chased just off the inside under a ride with five-sixteenths remaining, continued in the two path into upper stretch, weakened. SO ANGELINA raced just off the inside through the first turn and then four paths off the inside down the backstretch in closest aim of the leader, continued four wide into the far turn and came under coaxing three furlongs out, faded and went three to four wide into upper stretch, then tired in the drive and was eased home in the late stages.

VELORA settled off the pace, drafted behind the leaders in the two path on the turn, bumped LUCK PENNY soundly while trying to move forward impatiently just outside the quarter-pole, dropped to the inside while asked into upper stretch, rallied along the rail to get the lead outside the furlong marker, was given one pop of a right-handed crop at that marker, came under one more pop of the crop while drawing away outside the sixteenth-pole then was eased up while much the best. ANNOTATE hit the inside of the gate at the start, went to the front, set the pace under pressure to her outside, vied along the rail on the turn, spun into the stretch in the two path, lost the advantage to the winner outside the furlong marker and proved no match while clear for the place. DOITFORJACK chased the pace on the outside then in the four path on the turn, was bumped hard by LUCK PENNY who was knocked outward by VELORA coming to the quarter-pole, dropped back in upper stretch and tired. BLESSEDNOTBOTHERED was urged along at the rear, traveled around the turn in the two path, was driven into the stretch in the four path and failed to threaten. LUCK PENNY pressed the pace on the outside of the leader, vied in the three path on the turn, was bumped hard by VELORA approaching the quarter-pole and was forced out into DOITFORJACK then taken up while bounced around a bit, dropped back into upper stretch and capitulated. WILDEST DREAMS chased the pace on the outside, dropped back leaving the backstretch, went around the turn in the five path and faltered.

TUSCAN SKY coaxed from the gate, chased four then three wide coming under coaxing with seven-sixteenths to go, swung five wide into upper stretch, rallied to take command a furlong out, dug in head to head to the finish and prevailed gamely on the line. REASONED ANALYSIS dueled inside of MR. PAPAGIORGIO from the get go, got set down spinning just off the inside into upper stretch, shook off his main pace rival confronted by the top one and was headed for the front a furlong out, fought on to the finish to preserve the place honors on the wire. DREAMLIKE chased just off the inside until tipped three then four wide put to encouragement with seven-sixteenths to run, angled six wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive latched on the top pair inside the final furlong but was ultimately repelled by both to the finish while well clear and best of the rest. GEWURZTRAMINER chased along the inside and then just off the inside, swung three wide into upper stretch in range of the front, got flashed the crop to the right side intermittently while never extended through to the finish. MR. PAPAGIORGIO broke out at the start and was corrected, dueled three then two wide with REASONED ANALYSIS to his inside, came under coaxing near the quarter pole and tipped four wide into upper stretch, got shaken off straightened away and tired through to the finish.

SASSMASTER coaxed from the gate, knocked heads briefly for the front before easing off to chase along the inside through the first turn and then two to three paths off the inside down the backstretch, went just off the inside through the far turn coming under encouragement with five-sixteenths to go, angled four wide into upper stretch, rallied to take command just outside the eighth pole, dug in to inch away in the late stages. DAKOTA COUNTRY chased two to three paths off the inside down the backstretch, tucked inside into the turn and came under coaxing near the quarter pole, went eight wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive rallying through the final furlong knocking heads late with JOKER ON FIRE and was just up on the wire. JOKER ON FIRE broke out at the start trading a bump with MOZAMBIQUE, chased along the inside coming under coaxing near the quarter pole, angled five wide into upper stretch, rallied to take command just inside the eighth pole, dug in head to head with the top one late and was nailed on the line. ILLMATIC tracked the pace along the inside continuing along the inside route into upper stretch, paused in behind the leader BLAMICKER with KING PUCK to his outside with nowhere to go but remain boxed along the rail until gaining clearance just inside the eighth pole, tipped out roused for the remainder of the stretch and closed with a rush to just miss for the it all at the end. VAN VOLLENHOVEN two to three wide in pursuit from just off the pace, came under a ride near the quarter pole and spun three wide into upper stretch, rallied to take command at the eighth pole, got displaced just inside that station, then weakened in the late stages. HEDGE BOOK angled in early, traveled around the first turn in the two path, settled off the pace, was asked while moving from the inside to the three path on the far turn, came into the stretch in the five path and lacked the needed response. TIMELESS MELODY saved ground towards the back, was roused on the far turn and failed to threaten. MUSIC BOX went to the front, contested the pace on the inside while in hand, was asked at the quarter-pole, battled under a drive in upper stretch, dropped back into the final furlong and tired.
