SILLY SEASON raced three then two wide through the first turn, tracked the leader from the two path into closest aim, advanced to take command just outside the quarter pole and took the inside route into upper stretch, dug in under a drive under threat to the outside, came out bumping her main danger twenty yards from the finish and just held on to prevail. LYN'S LEGACY just off the inside just off the pace, came under coaxing three furlongs out, spun three wide into upper stretch, lugged in switching leads straightened away and bumped COACH OF THE YEAR, dug in under a drive rallying to latch on the top one inside the eighth pole, had that rival come out twenty yards from the finish and was bumped and then just missed on the wire. ROSEMONT GARDEN raced three then two wide into the first turn before settling along the rail briefly before tipping back to be just off the inside down the backstretch, remained in the two path through the far turn coming under coaxing three furlongs out, angled five then four wide into upper stretch, closed well to the finish to latch on the top pair as they hit the line. COACH OF THE YEAR tracked the pace along the inside, came under urging tipped to the two path with five-sixteenths to go, continued just off the inside into upper stretch and was bumped by the LYN'S LEGACY straightened away, dug in behind the leader through to the eighth pole, ran on to the end. PAULA'S CHOICE saved ground in pursuit from mid pack coming under urging with seven-sixteenths remaining, angled four then three wide into upper stretch, stayed on one paced to the finish. JARNDYCE coaxed from the gate, chased two to three wide under a ride from the three-eighths pole, angled five wide into upper stretch, tired. ADDAGIRL ADDIE a bit uncooperative in the gate unwilling to straighten her head, got corrected and lunged at the break getting away last, raced three then two wide into the first turn before taking to the rail midway on that bend, chased along the inside coming under coaxing at the three-eighths marker, spun just off the inside into upper stretch and made no impact. FORCE OF MISCHIEF established the front the first time under the wire and showed the way in hand along the inside through sensible splits, had the pressure intensify midway on the far turn and came under urging with five-sixteenths to run, yielded the front near the quarter pole and took the inside route into upper stretch, then faltered in the drive. ADROIT grew fractious in the gate two times prior to the start resulting in the rider hopping off twice before the load was completed, the assistant starter doing a great job with a strong hold to protect both horse and rider in both instances, raced three then two wide through the first turn, chased two to three wide coming under a ride three furlongs out, angled five wide into upper stretch and made no impact.

HOT CURRENCY brushed the outside of the gate at the start, was hustled to the front then taken in hand, showed the way while well rated under a snug hold, controlled the action while inside to the two path on the turn, responded well when asked at the quarter-pole, extended the advantage while moving a bit further out in the track in upper stretch, came under one pop of a right-handed crop outside the furlong marker, was given one more pop of the crop while drawing off inside that marker, raced under a solid hand-ride into the final sixteenth then was eased up while much the best. GRACE AND GRIT bumped with a rival at the start, dropped to the rear then settled at the back, moved closer near the nine-sixteenths pole, was roused with a half-mile to run, went around the turn in the three path, dropped to the two path under a strong drive into the stretch and just got up to nail NINA KAY for the place. NINA KAY was urged early then moved up to race just behind the leader, raced under a tight hold along the rail, was asked outside the five-sixteenths pole then moved to the two path, came out some while chasing the winner in upper stretch, pursued that foe into the final sixteenth and was caught for the place while clear for the show. ZI END brushed the inside of the gate then bumped with a foe at the start, settled on the outside, was roused in the three to four path on the turn, raced just off heels briefly inside the five-sixteenths pole, spun into the stretch in the five path, swapped back to her inside lead outside the sixteenth-pole and came up empty. BELLACOSE broke out and bumped with MISSING FORTUNE, pressed the pace on the outside, chased in the two to three path on the turn, dropped back in the four path into the stretch and faltered. MISSING FORTUNE was bumped at the start, settled off the pace, was asked in the two path on the turn, dropped to the rail late on that bend and failed to respond.

NORWICH coaxed from the gate, prompted the leader from the outside, four paths off the rail down the backstretch, tucked to the two path through the turn and advanced to duel from the three-eighths pole, spun two to three wide into upper stretch, continued to knock heads through the stretch taking narrow command a sixteenth out, dug in gamely between foes late and just held on to score. SHOOT THE NICKEL broke in at the start bumping STEWIE into CONNIVING, chased five paths off the inside down the backstretch and then just off the inside through the turn coming under encouragement with five-sixteenths to run, spun three wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive and got on track nearing the sixteenth marker, surged late and just missed on the wire. BURNINHUNKOFLOVE coaxed from the gate, showed the way in hand just off the inside under some pressure from NORWICH to the outside, tucked inside through the turn and came under increased pressure engaged in head to head combat from three furlongs out, took the inside route into upper stretch under a drive, dug in and was narrowly headed a sixteenth out, fought on inside the top pair through the final sixteenth to the finish. CONNIVING got bumped after the start by STEWIE due to pressure from SHOOT THE NICKEL breaking inwards, chased three then two wide patiently handled until set down spinning just off the inside into upper stretch, ran on through to the end. KUNSHAN BRIDGE chased six to seven paths off the rail down the backstretch and then three wide through the turn coaxed along with seven-sixteenths remaining, angled four to five wide into upper stretch, made no headway. STEWIE got bumped after the start by SHOOT THE NICKEL and in turn bumped CONNIVING, chased six paths off the inside down the backstretch and then three wide through the turn, went four wide at the top of the stretch and weakened in the late stages. JACKSON HEIGHTS broke out at the start brushing WILLIE BIRD, chased two to three wide under a ride from three furlongs out, went seven to eight wide into upper stretch, made no impact. WILLIE BIRD a bit fractious in the gate prior to the start, lunged at the break and was brushed by JACKSON HEIGHTS getting away last, chased seven paths off the inside down the backstretch and then three wide through the turn, went eight wide at the head of the stretch, made no impact.

SEA STRIKE coaxed from the gate, got floated out four wide into the first turn by the leader GULFY and in turn carried CHIEF WALLABEE briefly five wide and BLACKOUT TIME six wide, tucked three wide directly after and settled three wide just off the leader into the backstretch, remained patiently handled tracking that rival in closest aim on hold until given a notch to work with just inside the five-sixteenths marker, advanced to take command just outside the quarter pole and spun just off the inside into upper stretch and was roused straightened away, went clear under a drive and was geared down inside the final sixteenth to the finish with the outcome in no doubt. CHIEF WALLABEE got floated out five wide into the first turn and was eased off to tuck four wide behind the aforementioned foe before continuing in three then two wide coming under a rating hold into nearing the backstretch when pulling a bit keen briefly before settling behind SEA STRIKE three paths off the rail down the backstretch, continued three wide through the far turn and came under light coaxing nearing the quarter pole, angled four wide into upper stretch set down for the drive, proved no match for the top one while keeping on clear of the rest along second best and was geared down outside the sixteenth pole with the place honors sewn up. BOUQUETRY established the front and showed the way in hand along the inside under pressure from STARSHIP LIZZY to the outside, came under coaxing near the quarter pole and spun just off the inside into upper stretch, came under a left handed crop and shied out while edging away nearing the sixteenth marker, then got corrected under a right handed crop and was kept to task to prevail. STARSHIP LIZZY pressed the pace of the aforementioned foe from the outside three then two wide coming under a ride with five-sixteenths to go, swung four wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive pausing very briefly when the aforementioned foe shied out while clear in front near the sixteenth pole, then kept on safe for the place honors. ALL BRIGHT broke out at the start filling the space left vacant by BATTLE RIFLE and forcing that foe to check when squeezed out and taking over her lane, chased along the inside and then just off the inside under urging from the seven-sixteenths marker, angled four wide into upper stretch and offered up a mild kick to secure the show honors. JAYME'S TURN grew fractious in the gate prior to the start, chased three wide coming under a ride with five-sixteenths to go, angled five wide into upper stretch, weakened in the late stages. TACTICALLY chased four then three wide under a ride from the seven-sixteenths marker, angled six wide into upper stretch and weakened. MY DEVINE ONE chased five paths off the inside down the backstretch, tucked four then three wide through the turn under coaxing from the seven-sixteenths pole, swung five wide into upper stretch and made no impact. BATTLE RIFLE stumbled badly at the start and was forced to check when squeezed out and losing her lane to ALL BRIGHT and conceded six to seven lengths to the front before settling into stride, chased three wide down the backstretch, briefly tucked to be just off the inside and then along the inside near the half mile pole before heading back three wide

midway on the turn, went four to five wide into upper stretch and trailed throughout. There was an objection by the rider of STARSHIP LIZZY alleging interference in the stretch from BOUQUETRY. After review, the claim of foul was dismissed and the result was allowed to stand prior to the race being declared official.
