SMART UNCLE settled tracking the spurting away leader from the two path among the front of the main flight, jumped well to maintain his placing, took closer order on the front with the rest of the field after jump seven and nearing flight eight, cleared the final two jumps and remained patiently handled until called upon leaving the final turn of the flat, rallied inside the final furlong to collar the leader seventy yards from the finish and dug in to score. FIL DOR (FR) tracked the pace along the inside from mid pack jumping well to maintain his position, came under urging after the final flight and improved position through the final turn, rallied in the stretch issuing a challenge through the final sixteenth and was just up for the place honors on the wire. ROJA REDEMPTION settled tracking the front from just off the inside in mid pack, jumped well to maintain and even gain ground among the main flight, took closer order after jump seven and took over to show the way of the main flight getting first run at the once clear leader approaching fence eight, seized command just outside that jump and showed the way from there through the final flight, edged clear in the flat through to the eighth pole, dug in under growing threat from a pair of rivals offering flanking challenges and was caught seventy yards from the finish by one and then nailed on the line by the other while well clear for the show honors. SALTED CARMEL tracked the pace along the inside from just off the pace, jumped late at fence five and lost some ground and position, came under urging after the final fence and offered up a mild kick to the finish. ST JAMES THE GREAT settled tracking the spurting away leader in closest albeit far aim while just off the inside showing the way among the main flight, jumped late at fence five, came under urging once in the flat and weakened to the finish. L'AVVOCATO (FR) saved ground tracking the front from the tail of the field, jumped well with the exception of jump seven when jumping early, came under urging in the flat and made no impact. TAKE YOUR SEATS (IRE) spurred away on the pace from the two path opening up a commanding lead, jumped late at fence three, had the field take closer order after fence seven and was displaced from command nearing flight eight, dug in under a drive after the final fence and faltered in the flat. MCTIGUE (IRE) saved ground near the rear of the field, jumped well to maintain position, tipped out three wide through the fourth turn after fence seven and advanced in contention on the outside, was fourth when jumping very late and fell at the final flight, was vetted and attended to after running off briefly and was subsequently transported off the course via the equine ambulance.

FABIAN'S PRINCESS went to the front, showed the way while well rated a bit off the inside, dropped to the rail early on the turn, responded well when asked at the quarter-pole, came under a right-handed crop in upper stretch, maintained a safe advantage into the final sixteenth and proved best under a strong hand-ride late. PROMISE ME AMELODY moved up to be well placed just off the pace, drafted inside on the turn, was roused in the two path into the stretch, chased the winner in the drive and was second best. CARMEN AMALIA stumbled at the start then brushed with a foe but broke clearly in front, prompted the pace on the outside of the leader, chased in the three then two path on the turn, spun into the stretch in the three path and weakened but was clear for the show. ALLEGRO BRILLANT broke in then hit the gate and was off slow, settled at the rear, moved out of last at the nine-sixteenths pole, was roused while shifting from the two path to the four path on the turn, advanced closer late on that bend, turned into upper stretch under a drive and came up empty. QUIDDITY lugged out while traveling awkwardly down the backstretch, dropped to the rear at the nine-sixteenths pole, retreated in the five path on the turn, came out into upper stretch and was pulled up then transported off the track via equine ambulance.

MARIA LOUISE broke out at the start bumping WEDELIA, prompted the pace of EMPRESS NEW GROOVE from the outside three then two wide coming under coaxing near the quarter pole, spun three wide into upper stretch and seized command straightened away, edged clear under a drive to prevail. NOBLE GLOW chased just off the inside and then along the inside under a ride from three furlongs out, angled three to four wide into upper stretch, ran on to chase the winner home well clear of the rest and along second best. MISS TWITTER coaxed from the gate, raced four wide through the opening dog legged turn, chased five then four paths off the inside down the backstretch and then just off the inside through the far turn coming under coaxing near the five-sixteenths pole, went seven wide into upper stretch and improved position to the finish. WEDELIA got bumped at the break by MARIA LOUISE who broke outwards, went three wide through the first turn and then five paths off the inside down the backstretch, tucked three wide through the far turn coming under coaxing near the quarter pole, angled five wide into upper stretch and weakened in the late stages. EMPRESS NEW GROOVE had the rider get off balance at the start leaning to the right side and came under coaxing corrected and broke on top despite it, showed the way in hand along the inside under pressure from MARIA LOUISE to the outside, came under coaxing with five-sixteenths to go, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, yielded the front straightened away and weakened to the finish. SLOW KARA briefly five wide, tucked four then three wide through the first turn, chased four then three wide under urging from the half mile pole, went eight to nine wide into upper stretch and tired. RECONNECTED chased along the inside and then just off the inside under a ride from the half mile pole, drifted out four wide under urging three furlongs from home, continued four wide into upper stretch and trailed.

ROSSBEIGH was taken in hand early, raced in the two path under restraint on the first turn, pulled his way forward early on the backstretch, was asked in the three path on the far turn, gained to get the lead into upper stretch, kicked clear under a right-handed crop while remaining on his inside lead outside the furlong marker, swapped to the proper lead while switched to a left-handed crop near the furlong maker, remained clear into the final sixteenth and held under a hand-ride late. BOURBONCENTRIC was hustled from the gate, went around the first turn in the two path, tugged on the bit while getting closer early on the backstretch, was asked while inside to the two path on the far turn, shifted to the three path into the stretch, pursued the winner in the drive, gained on that foe with good courage late but missed while clear for the place. NONNO JOE saved ground while reserved off the pace, was roused in the two path at the quarter-pole, steadied while blocked behind a wall of horses in upper stretch, altered out for room outside the furlong marker and finished with good energy to secure the show. BEAU CHEVAL saved ground under snug restraint on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, went around the far turn in the two then three path, was asked for his best in upper stretch and lacked the needed response. VITALIZE saved ground while hard held on the first turn, came out early on the backstretch, was reserved off the pace, traveled around the far turn in the two then three path, moved out in upper stretch and failed to rally. CLASSIC COMMANDER broke a step slow, raced under tight restraint in the four path on the first turn, dragged his way forward early on the backstretch, bumped with ROSSBEIGH near the three-quarter pole then tossed his head while keen, raced on the outside, was asked in the four path on the far turn, dropped back in the five path into the stretch and came up empty. WAZEY'S CHARM dropped back just after the start, bumped with PORTADOWN LAD early on the first turn, tossed his head in the three path on that bend, was reserved off the pace, went around the far turn in the two then three path and also failed to rally. SUNSHINE BOBALOU broke out and a step slow, went around the opening bend in the three path, settled at the back, moved from the hedge to the four path on the far turn, came into the stretch in the five path and was no factor. BERMAN established a forward position early, rounded the first turn in the three path under snug restraint, tugged his way forward early on the backstretch, contested the pace on the outside, was urged along late on the backstretch, vied in the two path on the far turn, dropped back in upper stretch and tired. PORTADOWN LAD was taken in hand, bumped with WAZEY'S CHARM early on the first turn, raced in the four path on that bend, settled outside on the backstretch, was roused in the three then four path on the far turn and failed to threaten. FOLLOWWILL moved in while going to the front then quickly sped clear, raced inside on the first turn, was challenged to his outside early on the backstretch, vied inside while asked on the far turn, dropped back into upper stretch and capitulated.
