GAUDREAU showed speed then pressed the pace on the outside, vied in the three path for most of the turn then dropped to the two path, took the lead while asked into upper stretch, inched clear under a strong-hand ride into the final furlong, was put to a left-handed crop outside the sixteenth-pole and held under strong urging. COACH POPE came in just after the break which carried in U. S. S. VALOR, brushed with GORILLAZ early, was rated while well placed just off the pace, saved ground on the turn, tipped to the two path approaching the quarter-pole, was roused in the three path into the stretch, pursued the winner under a drive into the final furlong, gained into the final sixteenth, made a bid late and missed while just able to get the place. U. S. S. VALOR broke last but one then was carried in just after the start, moved out to avoid hitting the rail leaving the chute, settled comfortably off the inside, came out some when the rider pulled his goggles down late on the backstretch, ranged up in the two to three path on the turn, steadied briefly off the heels of GORILLAZ when that foe came in a path around the five-sixteenths pole, was roused shortly thereafter then shifted to the four path, turned into the stretch in the five path, remained on his inside lead until outside the furlong marker, swapped to the proper lead when pulled in by the jockey at that juncture, gained under a right-handed crop into the final sixteenth and finished with good courage to just miss the place while far clear for the show. GORILLAZ was sent hard from the gate then taken in hand when the pacesetter crossed in the front and took his path, brushed with COACH POPE at that point, raced just off the pace under restraint while behind horses, was asked while in the two to four path on the turn, dropped back to the three path near the five-sixteenths which put U. S. S. VALOR off heels, chased into upper stretch, dropped back into the final furlong and tired. BELLISSIMO D'ORO broke fast and went straight to the front then angled in early, showed the way on the inside of a foe, vied in the two path for most of the turn then dropped to the inside, was headed into upper stretch, dropped back into the final furlong and capitulated. WITH LUCK FORWARD was hustled from the gate then urged along near the back, shied out when U. S. S. VALOR came out near him late on the backstretch, went around the turn in the three path and was no factor. STAR SALUTE dropped back while lacking speed under urging, angled in around the nine-sixteenths pole, saved ground on the turn and showed little. HEMINGWAY tracked the pace on the outside, dropped back in the four to five path on the turn, retreated into the stretch then moved to the three path and faltered.

ADMIRALTY got brushed at the break by TOMMY TANG, who broke outwards, chased four to five paths off the inside down the backstretch, tucked three wide through the turn and advanced on the top pair isolated between those two rivals and the rest of the field in behind, swung five then four wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive latching on the top pair just outside the eighth pole, came in slightly and bounced IMPLIED OPEN around lightly in tandem with MYSTRIX a sixteenth out, battled head to head to the finish and just got the nod on the wire. MYSTRIX got bumped at the start by STONE AGED and came under hustling to establish the front soon after, showed the way in hand three then two wide and came under steadily increasing pressure from IMPLIED OPEN through the turn until engaged in head to head combat with five-sixteenths to go, spun three then two wide into upper stretch, dug in under threat and was joined outside by the top one near the eighth pole, clung to command coming out slightly a sixteenth out and bumped around IMPLIED OPEN in concert with ADMIRALTY and was headed narrowly at that station, fought on and just lost the bob on the line. IMPLIED OPEN raced four wide in aim of the front before tucking three wide into the turn and steadily increasing pressure on the aforementioned foe until engaging that rival in a duel from the five-sixteenths marker, swung four wide into upper stretch, dug in head to head and got joined outside by the eventual winner, fought on between rivals getting bounced around lightly a sixteenth out and gamely ran on through to the finish undeterred. MAGICAL MIKEL chased along the inside under a ride from three furlongs out, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, weakened. SHARPLY DRESSED got bumped at the start by LIVE breaking inwards, chased just off the inside under a ride from the seven-sixteenths pole, tipped out four wide into upper stretch and made no headway. STONE AGED broke out at the start bumping MYSTRIX, chased five paths off the inside down the backstretch before tucking inside through the turn coming under coaxing at the three-eighths marker, angled five wide into upper stretch and offered no rally. CODE OF ARMS broke awkwardly at the start and then got steadied after the break, chased six to seven paths off the inside down the backstretch before tucking inside through the turn, came under a ride three furlongs out, angled

seven wide into upper stretch and made no impact. IRON CONFESSOR chased five paths off the rail down the backstretch before tucking to the two path half a mile from home, tipped three wide into upper stretch and made no impact. LIVE broke in brushing the near side stall at the start before bumping SHARPLY DRESSED, chased three wide under a ride from the seven-sixteenths pole, angled eight wide into upper stretch and tired. TOMMY TANG broke out at the start brushing ADMIRALTY, chased two to three wide, got out despite a firm left hand grip and right crop at the seven-sixteenths four to five wide, angled seven wide into upper stretch and faltered in the drive.

SAN SIRO was hustled from the gate then dropped back under urging early, saved ground on the first turn, settled at the rear, was urged along while dropping from the three path to the rail on the far turn, came under the crop nearing the five-sixteenths pole, was driven into the stretch in the three path, moved out under a left-handed crop outside the eighth-pole, rallied into the final furlong and closed strongly to get up late and prevail. YO DADDY brushed with a rival at the start then was hustled to establish a forward position, raced in the three path on the first turn, prompted the pace on the outside through quick fractions, was asked in the two path on the far turn, turned into upper stretch on even terms for the lead, took a short lead outside the furlong marker, led into the final sixteenth but was caught while just able to get the place. FULL SCREEN broke out then was corrected by the rider, tossed his head while inside on the first turn then moved to the two path late on that bend, climbed some while dropping back onto the backstretch then continued to drop farther off the pace, was roused while going from the inside to the three path on the far turn, moved closer in the process, chased into upper stretch, began to drift out while gaining outside the eighth-pole, continued to drift out some while chasing in the final furlong, gained to make a bid late but just missed the place while well clear for the show. INSTANT REPLAY was fractious in the gate and charged the front of the stall, brushed with an opponent at the break, went around the first turn in the four path, dropped back early on the backstretch, settled on the outside, was urged along with a half-mile to run, traveled around the far turn in the three then four path while getting closer, turned into upper stretch under a drive and lacked the needed response. HAND OVER HEART got checked at the start when MERMAID veered out taking over her lane and conceded four to five lengths to the front before settling into stride, chased three then two wide through the first turn before heading three paths off the hedge down the backstretch, continued three wide through the far turn coming under coaxing near the quarter pole before being set down spinning seven to eight wide into upper stretch, closed in through the final furlong in tandem with SAIL WITH THE WIND to overthrow the leader just inside the sixteenth marker and then was just up on the wire to share in the victory. SAIL WITH THE WIND raced just off the inside through the first turn and then four paths off the inside thereafter remaining patiently handled until roused angled seven wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive rallying in concert with the aforementioned foe through the final furlong overtaking the

In a pelting rain from a passing through squall, DETERMINISTIC coaxed from the gate, settled tracking the leader in closest aim just off the inside patiently handled until placed to coaxing nearing the quarter pole, spun three wide into upper stretch, rallied to take command a furlong out, edged clear under a drive to score. After review, both objections were dismissed and the result was allowed to stand prior to the race being declared official.

SOVEREIGNTY raced just off the inside through the first turn before tipping five paths off the rail down the backstretch settling unhurried near the rear of the field, tucked four wide at the half mile pole and came under light coaxing with seven-sixteenths to go, advanced steadily through the far turn and angled five to six wide into upper stretch, got fully engaged by the rider straightened away for home, rallied with good energy to collar the leader a furlong out, drew clear under a drive to prevail.
