STICKUPWITHOUTAGUN was bumped lightly in the hindquarters just after the start, displayed speed on the outside of INTO THE LIGHT in the two path on the first turn, went clear when that foe was taken back late on that bend, showed the way while well rated in the two path, extended the advantage on the far turn, responded well when roused into the stretch, came under a left-handed crop while a bit further out in the track outside the furlong marker, switched to a right-handed crop outside the sixteenth-pole, swapped back to his inside lead late and held under steady handling. INTO THE LIGHT was hustled from the gate, showed speed along the rail while inside of the winner on the first turn, was taken back off the pace late on that bend, settled just behind the pacesetter on the backstretch, moved from the inside to the three path while roused on the far turn, pursued the winner while remaining on his inside lead in upper stretch, swapped to the proper lead after being pulled in by the rider inside the furlong marker, continued after the winner to the finish and secured the place. JETS RIO broke out and bumped with BOLD LOVE, moved from the three path to the four path early on the first turn then dropped to the two path, was reserved off the pace, raced inside to the two path while asked on the far turn, was driven into the stretch in the four path and lacked the needed kick while well clear for the show. BOLD LOVE was bumped at the start and forced into another foe then checked while squeezed back, spotted the front several lengths, dropped from the two path to the inside on the opening bend, settled at the rear, came under urging late on the backstretch, moved from the four path to the five path early on the far turn, was brushed by FIRST BLESSING with three furlongs to run, dropped back to the four path before the five-sixteenths pole, spun into the stretch in the five path and lacked the needed response. FIRST BLESSING raced in the two to three path early on the first turn then moved to the four path, settled on the outside, came under encouragement outside the half-mile pole, was ridden along in the four path early on the far turn, came out a bit and brushed with BOLD LOVE at the three-eighths pole, dropped to the three path later on that bend, came out to the five path into the stretch then moved further out and failed to respond. WHO'S YOUR ZADDY was hustled from the gate, moved from the four path to the three path on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, was given his cue outside the half-mile pole, came up empty in the three then two path on the far turn and retreated then was eased in the final furlong but walked off.

EARLY AUTUMN chased four paths off the inside down the backstretch before tucking to the two path through the turn coming under coaxing three furlongs out, angled five wide into upper stretch, rallied to take command inside the sixteenth marker, then edged away to the finish to prevail. NIGHT SKY coaxed from the gate, chased three then two wide in closest aim of the leader coming under coaxing near the quarter pole and taking command at that station spinning just off the inside into upper stretch, dug in under threat and was collared three-sixteenths from home, ran on to secure the place honors. SOUTHERN KISS struck the off side stall at the start, chased three wide coming under a ride near the quarter pole, floated out five to six wide into upper stretch, rallied to take command with three-sixteenths to go, drifted out two to three paths before being corrected, got collared inside the sixteenth pole and was shown the crop to the right side to the finish while weakening late. SPLIT THE BLANKET coaxed from the start, vied briefly before emerging with sole command three paths off the inside, tucked inside and showed the way in hand along the inside, yielded the front just outside the quarter pole and took the inside route into upper stretch, then weakened in the drive. DENOS GRACE coaxed from the gate, chased just off the inside and then along the inside coaxed along nearing the quarter pole, spun three wide into upper stretch and weakened. WHITE STAR chased three then two wide coming under encouragement with five-sixteenths to go, went seven wide into upper stretch and made no headway. MISS MA'AM coaxed from the start, got coaxed along just off the inside down the backstretch and then along the inside through the turn, faded and angled three to four wide into upper stretch, then weakened through to the finish.

INTELLECT (FR) was taken in hand early, went around the first turn in the two path, was rated on the outside but with cover, moved from the two path to the four path on the far turn, was roused near the quarter-pole, rallied in the five path to get the lead near the three-sixteenths pole, kicked clear outside the furlong marker and proved much the best under steady urging. COSMIC YEAR (GB) bumped solidly with MAKES SENSE at the start, was rated just off the pace on the inside, moved to the two path late on the far turn, was asked at the top of the stretch, chased the winner under a drive to the finish and was second best. PAROS tucked in outside the seven-eighths pole, rounded the first turn in the two path, was reserved with cover, came under urging while going from two path to the five path on the far turn, moved out under a drive in upper stretch and lacked the needed response but was clear for the show. MAUI STRONG established a forward position early, stalked the pace on the outside in the three path, engaged the leader on the far turn, turned into upper stretch under a drive and came up empty. MAKES SENSE bumped solidly with COSMIC YEAR at the start, dropped back along the inside early, saved ground on the first turn, settled at the rear, was urged along in the two then three path on the far turn, came into the stretch in the four path then shifted further out and failed to threaten. FROSTED OVER became keen under restraint while outside early, dropped in with seven furlongs to run, raced in the three path on the first turn, settled near the rear, dropped back leaving the backstretch, dropped from the two path to the inside on the final turn and failed to rally. HIGH BETA brushed the inside of the gate at the start, went to the front, traveled around the opening bend in the two path, showed the way with a clear advantage, dropped in leaving the backstretch, was asked along the rail while challenged on the far turn, lost the lead at the quarter-pole and tired.

FREAKY coaxed from the gate, raced briefly in the two path before tipping out five paths off the rail down the majority of the backstretch, tucked three wide through the turn and came under coaxing near the quarter pole, swung five wide into upper stretch, rallied to take narrow command a furlong out, dug in under a drive dueling through the final furlong and gamely prevailed on the wire. SWAGING reluctant to load prior to the start, bobbled at the break, chased three to four paths off the inside down the backstretch and then just off the inside through the turn advancing to press the pace of ABRIGADO from the outside, swung four wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive and dueled through the final eighth fighting on game but was ultimately bested on the line. OVECHKIN went to the front, showed the way in the two path through solid fractions, extended the advantage late on the backstretch, dictated terms on the far turn, was asked coming to the quarter-pole, drifted out under a left-handed crop outside the furlong marker, switched to a right-handed crop outside the sixteenth-pole and held under steady urging. STREAM IT broke out at the start, dropped towards the rear while moving from the four path to the two path on the initial turn, settled well off the pace, was urged along passing the nine-sixteenths pole, dropped from the two path to the inside early on the far turn, saved ground while gaining into the stretch, moved out around the three-sixteenths pole, had the rider fumble his crop while trying to switch it from his left-hand to the right-hand approaching the furlong marker, shifted further out outside the sixteenth-pole and safely secured the place while under a hand-ride to the finish. LUZ DE GUIA got bumped at the start by DUTY, who broke out a step, chased five then four wide coming under a ride with five-sixteenths to go, swung four wide for home, rallied to take command nearing the eighth pole, then edged clear to the finish kept to task. LANGUID chased four then three wide under a ride with seven-sixteenths to go, spun three wide into upper stretch, kicked on belatedly to be along for the place honors in the late stages. ABOUT FACE prompted the leader from the outside four then three wide coming under a ride with five-sixteenths remaining, spun three wide into upper stretch, weakened in the late stages while along for the show honors. DUTY broke out a step at the start bumping LUZ DE GUIA, established the front and showed the way in hand just off the inside under close watch from ABOUT FACE to the outside, came under encouragement with five-sixteenths to run, cornered just off the inside into upper stretch, yielded the front near the eighth pole and weakened. MORTAL LOCK stumbled at the start and recovered outwards into GHOST DRIVER, chased along the inside and then just off the inside under prolonged coaxing from the half mile pole, took the inside route into upper stretch and tired. GHOST DRIVER got bumped at the start by MORTAL LOCK, who recovered outwards from a stumble, chased three to four wide, faded through the far turn growing detached at the tail of the field, continued three wide into upper stretch and was eased home to the finish.
