MATH TUTOR coaxed from the gate, dueled from the three path with SCHLOMO to his inside, took over command just inside the three-eighths pole, spun two to three wide into upper stretch, edged clear under a drive and was ridden out through the final sixteenth to the wire. EPITAPH brushed the off side stall at the start, chased along the inside until tipped three wide at the half mile pole, went three wide through the turn coming under encouragement three furlongs from home, went seven wide into upper stretch and improved position to the finish to procure the place honors. NANTZ chased five then four wide advancing through the turn to latch on the top pair through the latter portion of the bend coming under urging with five-sixteenths to go, swung five wide for home and kept on to the finish. FISTFULOFMONEY chased three then two wide under a ride from the three-eighths marker, took the inside route into upper stretch and weakened in the late stages. SCHLOMO coaxed from the gate, dueled from the two path with MATH TUTOR to the outside, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths pole, spun two to three wide into upper stretch and weakened. ANTIETAM broke out a step at the start bumping SALMING, chased four then three wide under urging from the seven-sixteenths marker, angled five to six wide into upper stretch and made no impact. SALMING got bumped at the start by ANTIETAM, chased five then four wide under urging from three furlongs out, went three to four wide into upper stretch, made no impact.

SCRAMJET broke alertly and went straight to the front then angled in early, set the pace under pressure to his outside, moved clear in the two path on the turn, was asked outside the quarter-pole then was challenged to the inside by MINDFELD while in the three path into the stretch, battled with that foe under a right-handed crop into the final furlong, was given one final pop of the crop outside the sixteenth-pole and edged clear late under a confident hand-ride while being flagged with a right-handed crop. MINDFIELD broke out and bumped soundly with SANTIS, was urged along off the pace, dropped from the five path to the inside on the turn, gained to make a bid inside of the winner into the stretch, remained on his inside lead while battling with that foe, swapped to the proper lead inside the three-sixteenths pole, fought with SCRAMJET into the final sixteenth and was outfinished while clear for the place. BIG HANDSOME broke alertly and showed speed, pressed the pace on the outside of the leader while loosely between horses, chased in the three path on the turn, turned into upper stretch in the four path while under a drive and weakened but earned the show. EQUILIBRATE broke in then was hustled, raced under urging early, took a few strides without urging when foes crossed in front around the five-eighths pole then came back under urging, went around the turn in the two path, was driven into the stretch in the three path while under the crop, moved out outside the furlong marker and failed to threaten. SARATOGA TEA was hustled from the gate then urged along off the pace, saved ground on the turn and lacked the needed response. SILVER KNIGHT showed speed then chased the pace on the outside, dropped back some in the four path on the turn, spun into the stretch in the five path, drifted out under a left-handed crop inside the three-sixteenths pole and tired. TOP THRILLER was off very slow then drifted in, spotted the front many lengths, saved ground while urged along at the rear and was no factor. UPPER ECHELON dropped back under urging while showing no speed, went around the turn in the two path and showed little. SANTIS was bumped soundly at the start, angled out under urging early, went around the turn in the four path and failed to respond.

ROAD SHOW four wide in pursuit, came under coaxing at the three-eighths pole, angled six wide into upper stretch, rallied to take command a sixteenth out, edged away under a drive to prevail. CUT DOWN THE NETS coaxed from the gate, prompted the pace of NEPTUNEROAD RICHIE from the outside four then three wide coming under coaxing near the quarter pole, swung three wide into upper stretch, seized command inside the three-sixteenths marker, dug in under threat and was caught a sixteenth out, kept on to preserve the place honors on the wire. J BUCK chased six to seven paths off the inside down the backstretch, tucked inside at the half mile pole, came under urging with five-sixteenths to go, swung four to five wide into upper stretch and offered up a mild kick. NEPTUNEROAD RICHIE coaxed from the start, showed the way in hand just off the inside and then along the inside under pressure from CUT DOWN THE NETS to the outside, took the inside route into upper stretch, yielded the front inside three-sixteenths to go and weakened. ARAWAK coaxed from the start, chased five then four wide under a ride from the five-sixteenths pole, swung four wide into upper stretch and weakened. WARTOENDALLWARS fractious in the gate prior to the start, got backed out briefly and reloaded, hesitated at the break getting away last and conceding five to six lengths to the front before settling into stride, chased just off the inside down the backstretch before floating out five to six wide through the turn, continued five wide into upper stretch and made no impact. NYSTATEOFMIND coaxed from the gate, chased six paths off the inside down the backstretch and then four to five wide through the turn coaxed along from the five-sixteenths marker, tipped seven wide into upper stretch and tired. PRIVATE BANKER broke in at the start filling the space left vacant by WARTOENDALLWARS, chased three then two wide under a ride from the five-sixteenths pole, continued to three wide into upper stretch and faltered in the drive.

CALLING CARD raced just off the inside through the first turn before chasing five paths off the inside down the backstretch, tucked four wide through the far turn and came under coaxing near the quarter pole, took over command swinging four to five wide into upper stretch, went clear under a drive and was geared down in the late stages. COME FULL CIRCLE raced four then three wide through the first turn, chased four then three wide coming under a ride near the quarter pole, spun three wide into upper stretch, proved no match for the top one while keeping on to secure the place honors clear of the rest. DINNER ROYALE chased along the inside under urging from the seven-sixteenths marker, angled five wide into upper stretch, improved position to the finish, then got pulled up after the gallop out and was attended to and vetted on track and was subsequently transported off the track via the equine ambulance. MCDIESEL a bit fractious in the gate prior to the start, showed the way in hand just off the inside coming under urging with five-sixteenths to go under challenge from a pair of rivals, yielded the front and took the inside route into upper stretch, weakened in the drive. BIG BROOKLYN a bit fractious in the gate prior to the start, chased along the inside under a ride from the seven-sixteenths marker, spun just off the inside into upper stretch and tired. TAKAHAMA four wide through the first turn, chased five to six paths off the inside down the backstretch and then four wide through the far turn, went six to seven wide into upper stretch and tired. CELTIC PRINCE stumbled at the break, went three wide through the first turn and was forced to steady in behind COME FULL CIRCLE seven furlongs out when that rival tucked in front while also getting brushed by BIG BROOKLYN to the inside, chased four then three wide under urging from the seven-sixteenths pole, angled six wide into upper stretch and made no impact.

MAXIMUM HEAT broke out and hit the gate, went around the first turn in the four path, moved up to get the lead early on the backstretch, went clear with five furlongs to run then moved in, dropped from the two path to the inside on the far turn, was asked inside the five-sixteenths pole, spun off the rail at the quarter-pole, drifted out while drawing off under a left-handed crop in upper stretch, swapped back to his inside lead when switched to a right-handed crop outside the furlong marker, was geared down by the rider outside the sixteenth-pole then went back to the proper lead and proved much the best. MO CURLS was hustled from the gate, raced in the three path on the first turn, dropped back inside the three-quarter pole then moved out with about five furlongs to run, was urged along passing the nine-sixteenths pole, went around the far turn in the four path, turned into upper stretch under a drive then moved in and safely secured second money. D C BOY'S broke out and hit the gate then bumped lightly with LOBBYIST, went to the front while inside on the first turn, lost the lead early on the backstretch then dropped just off the pace, chased in the three path on the far turn, drifted out in upper stretch and weakened. LOBBYIST was bumped lightly at the start then hustled, went around the early part of the first turn in the three then four path, dropped to the rail late on that bend, settled at the rear, was roused outside the half-mile pole, shifted from the rail to the three path while retreating on the far turn, dropped back in the five path into the stretch and faltered then was eased in the final furlong but walked off.
