ALEXIS ZORBA (GB) broke out at the start bumping REYNOLDS CHANNEL, tracked the front just off the inside until tipped to the three path at the five-sixteenths, got set down spinning three wide into upper stretch, rallied to take command a furlong out, inched away to the finish kept to task. COUSIN ED settled tracking just off the inside in pursuit from mid pack, got let out spinning three wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive rallying willingly to the finish and was along for the place honors on the line. REYNOLDS CHANNEL tossed his head and was bumped at the start by ALEXIS ZORBA, chased along the inside and then just off the inside under coaxing from the three-eighths, spun two to three wide for home and kicked on belatedly to secure the show honors. NANO MAN coaxed from the start, chased along the inside coming under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, angled five wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild kick. IDENTITY CRISIS vied inside a pair in hand until set down taking the inside route into upper stretch, dug in under threat and was collared a furlong out, kept on under a drive and was outfinished in the late going. RICHARD AVE chased along the inside under a ride from the five-sixteenths, continued in the inside route into upper stretch, kept on under a drive and was outfinished in the late stages. FILM ACADEMY coaxed from the gate, chased three wide under a ride from the five-sixteenths, tipped four wide into upper stretch, weakened in the late stages. HARD PAR chased three to four wide under urging from three furlongs out, angled six wide into upper stretch, offered no response. MAZZEI broke out at the start and was corrected, got steadied five furlongs out as COUSIN ED took to the rail directly in front, chased two to three wide under a ride from three furlongs out, spun three wide into upper stretch, made no impact. HOLDING THE LINE (IRE) vied three then two wide loosely between foes coming under coaxing near the quarter pole, spun just off the inside into upper stretch and tired. EPITAPH stumbled at the start getting away near the rear of the field, chased five wide under urging from the three-eighths marker, continued five to six wide into upper stretch and made no impact. FLY'N FRISBEE broke out at the start, came under light coaxing and vied outside a pair four then three wide, got out five wide midway on the turn and then got out nine to ten wide into upper stretch in retreat and folded in the stretch getting eased home to the wire.
