LONZO WHO pressed the early pace from between rivals, dueled into the turn then took command and shook free along the bend, held a clear lead to upper stretch then drew off late while in hand. DANZ AT COLFAX showed speed, dueled for pace duties three wide heading to the turn, could not match strides with the winner into the bend, stayed on into the stretch and held for the place. MICKEYS GOLD away in good order, tracked the early pace from the outside, ran in pursuit four to five wide nearing the top of the lane, made a mild late bid and just missed for the place, while holding for the show. SHUG'S ROCKET broke out at the start and bothered inner rival, settled off of the early pace, lugged out along the turn, ran in pursuit three to four wide heading to the stretch and was outkicked for the minor awards. NEW MEXICO JEREMY crowded then bothered at the start, trailed to the turn, coaxed two wide to the stretch, no threat late. SHAME ON WHISKEY broke a step slowly, rushed up along the inside and disputed the early pace, lost position into the turn and gave way in the stretch. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction, and it was re-timed using video technology to obtain the most accurate final time available. Internal fractions have been removed and are not available.
