PASS THE TEST commanded then pinched at the start, settled to the first turn, made a three wide middle move along the backstretch, vied for the lead into the far turn then took command, dug in while under pressure into upper stretch, responded well in the drive and kicked clear late under mild urging. MIXTERY broke in a step at the start then rated off of the early pace, advanced three then four wide into the far turn, vied to upper stretch, was outkicked by the winner in the lane and bested the rest for the place honors. DRAGONESSA close up to the early pace while three wide, stalked the pace four wide along the backstretch, vied between rivals into the far turn, yielded to the top pair in the late stages and held for third. DREAMILY lunged at the start and spotted the field to begin, rushed up along the inside and was well placed into the backstretch, chased from the inside into the far turn, got caught in traffic nearing the top of the stretch, angled out for the drive and missed for third. VENUS ROCKS took early command, set a contested pace into the backstretch, was overtaken into the second turn and weakened in the stretch drive. HALLIE'S GAL off a step slowly, lacked early speed and trailed to the backstretch, was last into the far turn and passed a tiring rival in the stretch. SEIS TACO'S prominent in the early stages, contested the pace between rivals into the backstretch, lost position into the far turn and tired in the stretch.
