CORRINA CORRINA allowed to settle early, was given her cue along the backstretch then loomed five wide approaching the far turn, vied for the lead three wide nearing the top of the lane, took command into deep stretch and edged clear late under mild urging. MARKING CANYON raced close up to the early pace, took back into the first turn then tracked the pace between rivals along the backstretch, navigated traffic into the far turn and was roused four wide into upper stretch, was gaining late, could not reel in the winner and was up in time for second. ANTONIOS MARK rated off of the early pace, was well placed while saving ground into the backstretch, gave chase into the far turn then mounted an inside rally into the stretch, was outkicked in deep stretch but held safely in the end for third. PROBATE prominent early, vied for the lead into the first turn then disputed the pace three deep into the backstretch, shook free into the far turn, was overtaken into upper stretch then yielded in the final stages. GHOSTLY CHANCE unhurried in the early stages, advanced along the backstretch run, weaved through rivals into the far turn, chased two wide to upper stretch, could not sustain a run into the lane and flattened out late. SHORT ROUND BOUND sent to vie for the early lead, assumed command into the first turn then disputed the pace while two wide along the backstretch, dropped back entering the far turn and had little left for the stretch drive. MY PEACHES Q prominent away from the gate, stalked the early pace three wide into the backstretch, got crowded a bit into the far turn, lacked the needed response nearing the top of the lane and gave way. MOJICA fractious prior to the start, bobbled a bit at the break but was forwardly placed early on, caught a bit wide into the first turn, took back then chased four wide along the backstretch, ran in pursuit into the far turn then tired in the late stages. THE STEWARDS CONDUCTED AN INQUIRY INTO AN INCIDENT OCCURRING AT THE QUARTER POLE, AND RULED NO CHANGE WOULD BE MADE.
