TRUCKIN settled off of the early pace then caught four to five wide to the first turn, tracked while widest into the backstretch, vied for the lead three wide nearing the far turn, confronted DRUM BUNNY and dueled to upper stretch, took command into the lane, held the runner-up at bay into deep stretch and proved best late. DRUM BUNNY crowded a bit at the start but away in good enough order, went up to contest the early pace from the inside, dueled into the far turn then met the bid of TRUCKIN midway through the bend, battled to upper stretch, was repelled in the lane and was well clear of the rest for second. RIO CUTIE close up in the early stages, stalked three wide to the first turn, tracked the pace three to four wide along the backstretch, lost ground to the second turn, was no match for the top pair into the stretch but stayed on late and held safely for third. DESERT PUNK sandwiched then pinched back at the start and spotted the field to begin, trailed to the backstretch, advanced from the inside along the far turn, could not find more into the stretch drive and was outkicked late for the show honors. FEAR THE CRUISE veered in at the start and bothered inner rivals, recovered and contested the pace to the backstretch, tracked to the far turn, lacked the needed response while two to three wide nearing the top of the lane and weakened in the drive. ROKI squeezed and jostled at the start, rushed up to the first turn then checked while on heels into that bend, recovered and disputed the pace between foes along the backstretch, vied into the far turn, could not keep pace nearing the top of the lane and tired in the late stages.
