MS. POUNDS broke alertly and pressed the early pace, dueled two wide into the turn, battled LORA LEE WHO to upper stretch, kept that foe at bay into the lane, dug in late and held over the oncoming runner-up. STORM IN THE VALLE tracked the early pace from the outside, well placed while three wide into the turn, chased the leading pair to upper stretch, responded well into the drive, surged late and just missed for the win, while getting up in time for the place. LORA LEE WHO hustled to contest the early pace, engaged with MS. POUNDS then dueled inside of that foe into the turn, fought gamely to upper stretch, grudgingly gave way to the leading pair in deep stretch and was well clear of the rest for the show honors. MOONLIGHT WARRIOR chased the early pace from the second flight, steadied when crowded by an inner rival into the turn, chased two to three wide to upper stretch, no late kick. QUEEN HADASSAH was close up away from the start then rated off of the early pace, trailed into the turn, swung four to five wide to upper stretch, no final kick. LEONAS GIRL off slow to begin, improved position heading to the turn, coaxed three then two wide nearing the top of the lane, no late kick. DISTORTED CAT prominent early on, stalked the pace from the inside heading into the turn, lost ground along the bend, gave way.
