MO MONEY TIME led the way between horses up the backstretch, continued around the turn in the two path and held clear to the wire. CORRINA CORRINA raced off the pace on the outside up the backstretch, swung out to the six path to began a bid approaching the quarter pole and gained ground late. DIAMANTE ELEGANTE bumped with the horse to her outside at the start, recovered to track the leader on the outside through the opening quarter, navigated the bend from the three path and kept on to the finish. RIGHT FOR YOU hit the gate leaving it, recovered to press the pace on the rail up the backstretch, saved ground around the turn and chased on from there. RUN AWAY BAY raced off the pace between horses early, swung out to the five path coming around the turn and made up some ground in the lane while never truly threatening. MARK IT DOWN bumped with the horse to her outside at the break, settled in the middle of the pack on the outside for the run up the backstretch, navigated the bend from the four path and was outkicked in the lane. SAPELLO SAMBA bumped with the horse to her inside leaving the gate, raced in the middle of the pack on the inside up the backstretch, came around the turn in the three path and was empty in the stretch. STORM IN THE VALLE chased the leaders up the backstretch, navigated the bend from the three path and faded in the lane. QUITE LOVELY bumped with the horse to her inside at the start, raced off the pace on the rail up the backstretch, saved ground around the turn and made no bid.
