CAPTAIN FABULOUS broke out at the start, sent and contested pace two wide to quarter, took command upper stretch, kept to task and proved best. DIABLO ROSSO stalked four to five wide to quarter, chased CAPTAIN FABULOUS into the lane, mounted a late bid and was second best. COPPER STATE off step slow, settled to turn, angled five wide upper, closed willingly and held for third. HANDMEDOWN D'ORO crowded start, tracked inside, rail bid to mid-stretch, flattened out. HANK HILL broke in, contested pace three wide to turn, yielded stretch. LET EM RIP close up, stalked four wide to turn, shuffled quarter, weakened lane. SPEEDY MONEY awkward start, tracked the early pace from outside, chased six wide to the quarter marker, gave way lane. MARK ME IN squeezed start, saved ground to turn, no factor stretch.
